1913-1993

Lewis Forge, 80, lifelong Bay Port resident, died Sunday, March 14, at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon, following a two-month illness.

He was born in Bay Port on February 8, 1913, the son of Charles and Myrtle (Lewis) Forge. He was married to Grace Light in Bay Port on July 21, 1934, and she survives him.

Mr. Forge had been a commercial fisherman in Bay Port for many years. He was a patrol boat officer and later a research boat captain for the Department of Natural Resources, before retiring in 1975.

Surviving, besides his wife, Grace, are two sons and their spouses, William C. and Janis Forge of Bay Port and Robert L. and Patricia Forge of Walled Lake, six grandchildren, eight great-grandchildren and two step-great-grandchildren.

One sister, Phyllis Anna Jackall, preceded him in death.

A memorial service will take place at 2 p.m. Saturday, March 20, at Bay Port United Methodist Church. Rev. Douglas Lefler will officiate. Cremation has taken place at Sunset Valley Crematory in Bay City. The family will receive friends at the church from 1 p.m. Saturday until the time of service.
