This 2015 Miro Cellars Conzelman Vineyard Anderson Valley Pinot Noir balances power and elegance. Its predominant red fruit aromas are supported by the judicious use of new French oak barrels. Cherry, cranberry and even some cassis and wild berry fragrances transcend the nose with soft heart notes of earthiness.

There is also a suggestion of rose petals and slight orange blossom as well..

Drink now or age properly for 3-5 years!!

Château de Chamirey

Built in early XVIII Century, Château de Chamirey is an elegant château, influenced by the Italian architecture, looking down on French garden. Built on a rocky headland, Château de Chamirey has a unique position on Mercurey vineyard.

On the palate, the wine is full-bodied, ample and pure, its chassis of fine tannins cloaked in an expansive core of ripe, almost candied fruit, underpinned by racy acids. A lavish bouquet of preserved red raspberry, cherry, strawberry & currant.

Navarro Vineyards has been growing grapes, making wine and producing non-alcoholic grape juices in the Anderson Valley in coastal Mendocino since 1974.

The flavor profile is a tart quince and green apple blend. I also detected a hint of nectarine and mild minerality. The finish is dry and fades away nicely.
