Our theater camp is an intensive six week program in the summer for your children. Your child will get training in auditioning, stage presence, voice, dance, and the technical aspects of live theater. Watch your child's talent and self esteem grow as trained professionals work with them daily from Monday through Thursday, 9 am to 3 pm. (If there are a lot of snow days and the children do not get out of school on time then the dates are subject to change and we will notify you. We will not give refunds if we have to change the dates.) The first five weeks of camp will be during the day Monday through Thursday, 9 am to 3 pm. The last week of camp will be in the evening for dress rehearsals and performances.

The age restrictions are firm for our camps. Your child must be 8 years old by the start of camp for the Lion King camp and 12 for the Bye Bye Birdie camp. Also, if the child has already graduated high school they are no longer eligible to register. We do not accept seniors that will graduate in May or June of 2017

To register you must fill in the form on the back and agree to the terms and conditions. You can either register online and mail this form in, or mail this form in to the address indicated on the back. Your child is NOT fully registered until we receive both your payment and this registration form. Even if you have paid you still must fill out, sign and return the registration form. (If registering online you will be required to fill out an online form.)

There will be an activity fee of \$450. Those that were 2016 repeat campers and register before September 30, 2016 will only have to pay \$425. Enrollment is subject to the terms and conditions on the registration form. (Register early because we always have to turn kids away!) Registration for new campers will NOT open until October 1, 2016. Please do not send your money in before then.

WE WILL NOT GIVE REFUNDS! BE SURE BEFORE YOU REGISTER YOUR CHILD. NO EXCEPTIONS AT ALL!!!

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. You certify that all the information you have provided to us is true and correct. You certify that your child is within the age set forth and that he/she has not graduated from high school.
2. You agree and acknowledge that there are no refunds for any reason.
3. All parents of children 13 and under MUST drop off and pick up their child from camp. The child is not allowed to walk to or from camp. If the child is over the age of 13 and you allow them to walk to and from camp they do so at their own risk.
4. We reserve the right to substitute another show for the shows that are pictured.
5. We will only accept 40 children for each camp. We reserve the right to adjust the age ranges of each camp.
6. We reserve the right to terminate your child's enrollment at any time for behavior problems. There will be no refunds.
7. We understand that your child may miss certain days due to illness or vacations. It is important to note that while we understand if your child misses it may hurt their chances of getting a good part in the show. We reserve the right to take any child out of numbers/scenes as we cannot reteach material.
8. It is our decision what parts your child will have and we will not discuss or answer any questions regarding casting of the shows. DURING THE COURSE OF THE CAMP IT MAY BE NECESSARY TO MOVE CHILDREN AROUND IN CERTAIN NUMBERS. IF YOU OR YOUR CHILD IS UNHAPPY WITH THE ROLE HE/SHE WAS GIVEN WE WILL NOT REFUND ANY MONEY FOR TICKETS/DVDS/ETC BECAUSE THEY NO LONGER WISH TO PARTICIPATE.
9. You agree that we may use any likeness of your child on our website, brochures, Facebook, publicity or other promotional items.
10. Please be prompt. Camp starts at 9 am sharp and ends at 3 pm sharp. If your child is not picked up by 3:15 we reserve the right to charge an additional fee of \$15 for each 15 minute increment.
11. You must provide a lunch for your child every day of camp. We cannot refrigerate these lunches.
12. You must tell us before you register if your child has a medical condition or other special needs.
13. You are required to give us one day of help with set construction or your child may be ineligible to register for the next year's camp.
14. You will be asked to provide some basic pieces for your child's costume. We will provide the rest.
15. We want children that want to be here. Please do not register your child if they do not want to participate. We will terminate any child that is disruptive to the program. There will be no refunds.
16. You must purchase all program ads and DVDs online unless sending with this original registration form. We will not accept money handed to any staff.
17. If there is a violation of these rules your child's enrollment is subject to termination.
