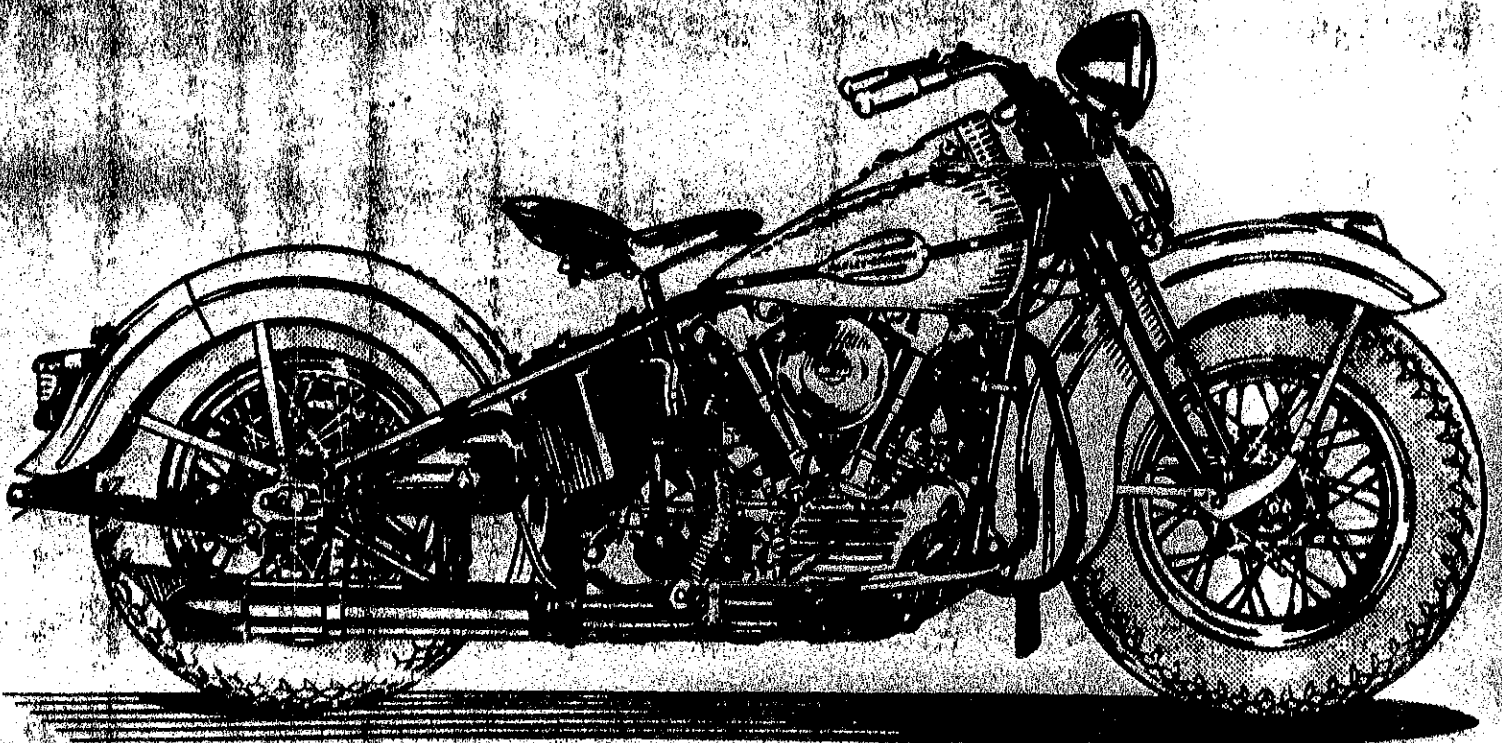

DECEMBER 1983

Enclosed with this newsletter is an application for the National and for our Chapter. The dues for 1983 are \$15.00 for the National and \$5.00 for our Chapter. You have two options of sending in your dues. You can send both applications with a check for \$20.00 to the Confederate Chapter, A.M.C., P. O. Box 41844 - Memphis, Tn. 38104. When we receive your applications we will process your National and Chapter for you and get your 1983 membership card from the National. We will then send it to you along with your Chapter membership card. You can send your application for the National directly to them as indicated on the application and send your Chapter application directly to us. Members who have joined since September have had their dues applied to the 1983 year for the Chapter. We will need your 1983 National membership number. Remember, you must be a National member in order to join the Confederate Chapter.

Last but not least is the May in Memphis show. We will have a Antique Cycle show in conjunction with the May in Memphis show. The date of the show is scheduled for May 28, 1983. An entry fee of \$5.00 (Five Dollars) will be charged for advance registration on each motorcycle entered. An \$8.00 (Eight Dollars) fee for registration will be charged if you enter the day of the show. Choppers and modified motorcycles will not be eligible for judging in the show. All judging will be conducted on a point basis only. Motorcycles from 1903 thru 1965 will be eligible. This is a great opportunity to display and create local interest in antique motorcycles.
