## Monthly Meeting Attendance

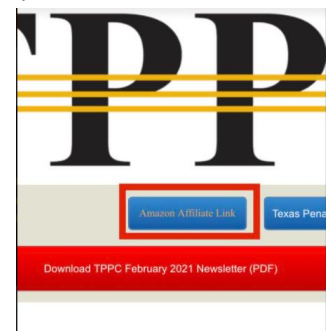

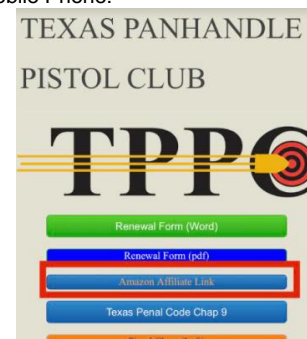
## Amazon Affiliate
