Statewide Stay-At-Home Order

The Director of the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services ordered a statewide stay-at-home order that went into effect on Monday, April 6, 2020, and shall remain in effect until 11:59PM, Friday April 24, 2020, unless extended by further order. Individuals shall avoid leaving their homes or places of residence. This Order does not prohibit people from accessing essential services, such as grocery stores, gas stations, and banks, or engaging in outdoor recreation, provided that necessary precautions are taken and maintained to reduce the transmission of COVID-19, including observing social gathering and social distancing requirements. The more that people reduce their public contact, the sooner COVID-19 will be contained and the sooner this Order will expire. Board of Trustees Meeting

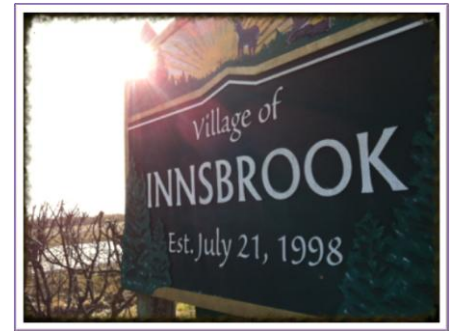
On Tuesday, April 14, 2020 at 5:00 pm, the Board of Trustees will hold the regular monthly meeting through Zoom Video Communications (Zoom), which is a cloud-based service that offers meetings and provides video conferencing capability. Individuals are not required to have a Zoom account to attend Zoom meetings, only the host [Village Administrator] is required to have an account to enable the control of the meetings. The public can join meetings using the Zoom mobile apps or desktop applications for Windows and Mac. This meeting is open to the public, similar to all of the Village meetings. The link and instructions to join this meeting will be provided on the meeting agenda and posted on the Village website. Your device's audio will be used for this meeting. All participants will be muted upon entry by the Administrator in order to avoid disruption. This will not affect the public's ability to view and hear the Board of Trustees throughout the meeting. A video copy of the meeting will be made available on the Village website within 24 hours following the meeting.

2020 Census Reporting

The Village has received notice from a number of residents, that the address on their 2020 Census is listed as Wright City instead of Innsbrook. The Village of Innsbrook does not have the ability to change this information, however we have contacted the Census Bureau for guidance. We hope the following information will help correct this issue. When responding online at **my2020census.gov**, log in with your 12 digit Census ID that was mailed to your household. When asked if you are responding for your address, select "No" and click NEXT. The site will ask you to enter your 12 digit Census ID once again. When asked if you have another Census ID, select "No" and click NEXT. This should walk you through adding your correct address and then proceed with the questionnaire. If you do not respond online, a paper questionnaire will be mailed to your address within the next few weeks.
