## Play Care, Boarding, Grooming Requirements

The following requirements are in place to ensure the safety of your dog, other dogs, you and our staff.

- All dogs must be on a leash when entering or leaving the building.
- All dogs must be current in all vaccinations as verified in writing by your veterinarian.
- All dogs over the age of 6 months must be spayed/neutered.
- We recommend that you bring your own food in during your dog's stay to
  prevent stomach upset or other problems. If your food supply is depleted
  before the end of your dog's stay or you wish PupTown to supply the food,
  there will be an additional charge.
- No personal rawhides or other types of toys are allowed with your dog.
   Personal blankets or bedding items may be brought for dogs staying in personal boarding suites only. All items must be machine washable. We cannot guarantee the condition of those items upon their return.
- You understand that even though all dogs are monitored closely, there is
  risk involved, including scrapes, cuts, etc. which are common place due to
  the nature of dog play. More serious injuries can not be predicted and you
  allow us to administer treatment directly or through a veterinarian. We will
  attempt to contact you if this occurs and you understand that any and all
  billing for medical services is the responsibility of the owner on file.
- Reservations are required for day care and boarding. If you need to cancel
  your dog's stay, we ask that you give us at least a 24 hour notice for day
  care and 72 hour notice for boarding or an additional fee may be charged.
- We reserve the right to discharge, disallow or stop any dog from utilizing any of our services to protect other dogs or our staff.
