

# Goat's Beard

This easy to grow Native perennial will grow anywhere from moist sun to dry shade. A tall accent for the back of the border, this plant is loved by pollinators and ignored by pests. Goat's Beard is a larval host for the Dusky Azure. It is also known to be edible and medicinal. This is a strong grower forming large plants that will outcompete unwanted invasives.

## *Aruncus dioicus*

- Hardiness: Zone 4-8
- Size: 4-6'
- Flower: White flowers in Spring
- Culture: Prefers Average to Wet, fertile soils and Sun to Shade
- Uses: Naturalizing, stream/pond edge, rain garden, drought, deer and rabbit tolerant, showy, pollinators, butterflies, birds, edible, medicinal, cut flower
