WHAT

IDPA is the use of practical equipment including full charge service ammunition to solve simulated real world self-defense scenarios using practical handguns and holsters that are suitable for self-defense use. The main goal is to test the skill and ability of an individual.

New shooters are required to attend orientation at 12:00pm before shooting.

Note: No Aluminum Ammo Allowed

REGISTRATION

This match will be run with a traditional squad based format. Practiscore preregistration is required to guarantee a spot; if squads are full and you did not preregister, you will not be able to shoot the match.

\$20/shooter. SSP, ESP, REV, CDP, CCP, BUG, CO, PCC allowed.

STAGES

This match will have 4 stages. Each string of fire will be 18 rounds or less, but stages may have up to 24 rounds minimum in them.

Accordingly to IDPA rules, you may only have 2 (or 3 for BUG/REV) magazines on your belt, but it is recommended you come to the firing line with 1-3 extra magazines in your pockets, especially for those of you shooting CCP/BUG/REV.

This may seem cumbersome, but it will allow shooters to maximize trigger time and minimize overall total time invested.
