As preparation for Lent, Carrie Lauber will be leading an Ash Wednesday service on March 5 at 6:00 p.m. You might ask, "What is Ash Wednesday?"

To join the group, bring your Bible (or not, since Bibles are always available) and a concordance, if you have one.



Our February focus is the Emergency Food Pantry. We FOOD PANTRY collected soup on Souper Bowl Sunday, and will be col-


