Lois Ann Janet Joslyn Boulden passed away peacefully on the first day of spring, March 20, 2026. Lois Ann was born to William Chandler Joslyn and Aldean Shirley (Davis) Joslyn on November 12, 1933 in Gillette. She was the youngest of nine and spent her early years in Wray, Colorado and Gillette before moving to Newcastle to attend high school. She graduated from Newcastle High School in 1951 and attended the University of Wyoming. She married her high school sweetheart, William Davis Boulden on November 7, 1954 at the Corpus Christi Catholic Church in Newcastle.
