

- Research questions effectively identified and completely referenced to specification
(questions/hypotheses clearly stated and explained and related to extracts from specification with relevant numbered points)
- Relevant literature sources, researched and theoretical and comparative contexts written up.
- Thorough use of relevant sources, contexts well understood and well stated.
(detailed research of background sources/ideas/concepts required. These need to be referenced in the text and listed in the bibliography)

(Theoretical, locational and comparative contexts needed. Comparative might look at how ideas/concepts have been applied in different circumstances which might have similarities and/or differences to your own study.)
