

# MINISTRY OF THE MESSIAH

The purpose of this illustration is to demonstrate the possible timeline of the last 3.5 years of Jesus Christ's life will present an alternative view of the timing of the historical sequence leading up to the Crucifixion. The crucifixion is presented in this study that corresponds to a total lunar eclipse or Blood Moon on Passover. No other eclipse, either solar or lunar that is total occurs on a Passover except the one on April 14, 32 AD. The supposition is that if Jesus was baptized at the end of summer on Elul 1, that would have started the 40 days of testing in the wilderness. The timeframe would have concluded on Yom Kippur where Jesus was given the Scroll of Isaiah and He read the 1st part of chapter 61. This echoed the type that He as to be the 'Scapegoat' and the atonement not only for Israel but for the world.

## ASTRONOMICAL VARIABLES AND PATTERNS

360 day/year timeframe x 40 = a factor of 14400

If the prophetic pattern of 40 is applied to the Temple, then

**40 years - 70 AD = 30 AD**

The year that Jesus started His public ministry.

### STAR OF DAVID ALIGNMENT

Another point of interest is that based on the research of John Charles Webb, a hexagram planetary alignment occurred during this time that presumes a commemoration of the Baptism of Christ just before a Passover and just before His 30th birthday.

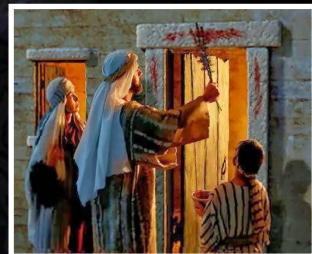
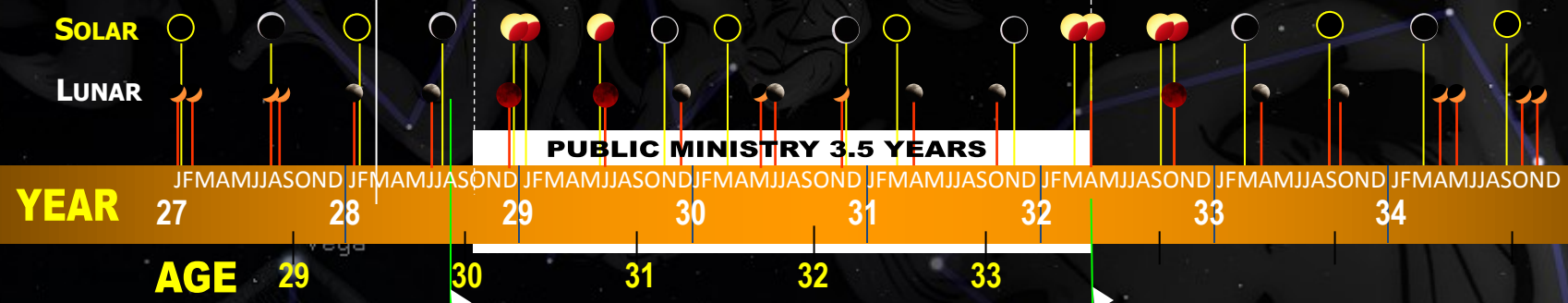
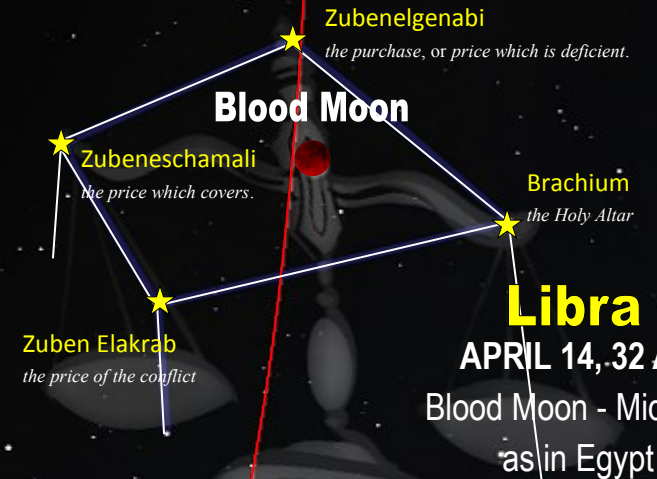
