Looks like this season is going to be a busy one!

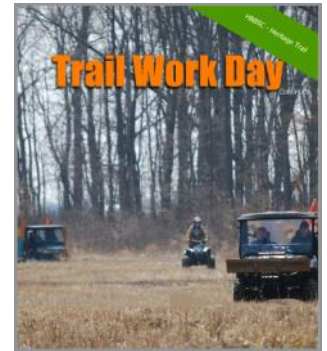
### Heritage Trail—1st Scheduled Work Day
