Edith Ann Quinn, 94 of Elkton, passed away Tuesday, Dec. 9, 1997, at the Huron County Medical Care Facility, Bad Axe.

She was born Sept. 21, 1903, in Meade Township, daughter of the late John and Sophia (Weaver) Grannell.

She married James Riley Quinn on Dec. 1, 1928, in Detroit. They moved to Elkton a short time later. He preceded her in death on May 12, 1975.

Mrs. Quinn received her teaching certificate from County Normal and taught at the Port Crescent School a number of years. She also served as bookkeeper at Flannery's in Bad Axe. She and her husband owned several businesses in and around Elkton, including Quinn's Hardware, a Case dealership and a Buick dealership.

She was a member of St. Francis Borgia Catholic Church and Altar Society, Pigeon, past president of the Elkton Women's Civic Club and had served as treasurer of the Elkton School Board from 1954 until the merger.

Surviving are her daughter, Mary (Dale) Truemner, Pigeon; three grandsons, Christian, Russell and Drew; her sister, Irene Schave of Harbor Beach, and her brother, Elwood Grannell of Bad Axe. Two sisters, Cassie English and Marguerite Eisengruber, preceded her in death.

A funeral mass was conducted Friday, Dec. 12 at St. Francis Catholic Church, with Rev. Michael Shine officiating. Burial was in Sacred Heart Cemetery, Bad Axe.
