

ORDINANCE NO. 3, 1961.

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A CUMULATIVE BUILDING AND SINKING FUND FOR A SEWAGE DISPOSAL PLANT AND SEWERS FOR THE TOWN OF CLOVERDALE, INDIANA.

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana, that it is deemed necessary to erect and construct a plant and sewers for the treatment and disposition of the sewage of the Town of Cloverdale and in order to provide funds therefor a cumulative building and sinking fund should be established by the levying of additional tax at the rate of fifty-five cents (\$.55) on each one hundred dollars of taxable property in the Town of Cloverdale, Putnam County, Indiana, to provide funds for said fund, said tax to be first levied in 1961, payable in 1962 and annually thereafter for a total period of three (3) years; and that notice of the adoption hereof be given to the taxpayers of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana, all as provided by Chapter 149, of the Acts of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana for 1949, as amended.
