Martha R. Wagner, 107, of Sebewaing, Huron County's oldest resident, died Wednesday, Aug. 23, 2000, at Courtney Manor in Bad Axe following a lengthy illness. She was born Jan. 1, 1893, in Sebewaing, daughter of the late Carl and Ernstine (Heinitz) Winter. She was baptized Jan. 14, 1894, in New Salem Lutheran Church and was confirmed April 8, 1906, at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Sebewaing. She was united in marriage to Omar F. Wagner on May 13, 1915, in Sebewaing. He preceded her in death on March 17, 1959. Martha was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church and its Ladies Aid.
