

# Thomas Leckenby Dies Monday <sup>1950</sup>

Funeral services will be held today (Thursday) at 2 p. m. at the Methodist church, Bad Axe, for Thomas Leckenby, 64, retired Colfax farmer, who passed away Monday afternoon at the Bad Axe General Hospital after a six-day illness of coronary thrombosis.

Mr. Leckenby was born April 17, 1885, in New Castle, Canada, and came with his parents, the late Mr. and Mrs. George Leckenby, to Oliver township in 1887. In 1911 he was united in marriage with Margaret Rowland at Bad Axe. They have lived in Bad Axe the past seven years. He was a member of the Bad Axe Methodist Church.

Surviving are his widow, two sisters, Mrs. Mary Stevenson and Mrs. Marie Krohn of Flint, and two brothers, Henry Leckenby of Hibbing, Minnesota, and John Leckenby of Elkton.

Rev. Robert McLean will officiate at the services. Interment will be in the Colfax cemetery, Bad Axe.
