First Lesson Isaiah 2:1-5 [1](#) The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem.[2](#) It shall come to pass in the latter days that the mountain of the house of the Lord shall be established as the highest of the mountains, and shall be lifted up above the hills; and all the nations shall flow to it,[3](#) and many peoples shall come, and say: "Come, let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, to the house of the God of Jacob, that he may teach us his ways and that we may walk in his paths." For out of Zion shall go the law, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.[4](#) He shall judge between the nations, and shall decide disputes for many peoples; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks; nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war anymore.[5](#) O house of Jacob, come, let us walk in the light of the Lord.

Second Lesson Romans 13:11-14 [11](#) Besides this you know the time, that the hour has come for you to wake from sleep. For salvation is nearer to us now than when we first believed.[12](#) The night is far gone; the day is at hand. So then let us cast off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light.[13](#) Let us walk properly as in the daytime, not in orgies and drunkenness, not in sexual immorality and sensuality, not in quarreling and jealousy.[14](#) But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to gratify its desires.

Gospel Luke 1:5-17 [5](#) In the days of Herod, king of Judea, there was a priest named Zechariah, of the division of Abijah. And he had a wife from the daughters of Aaron, and her name was Elizabeth.[6](#) And they were both righteous before God, walking blamelessly in all the commandments and statutes of the Lord.[7](#) But they had no child, because Elizabeth was barren, and both were advanced in years.[8](#) Now while he was serving as priest before God when his division was on duty,[9](#) according to the custom of the priesthood, he was chosen by lot to enter the temple of the Lord and burn incense.[10](#) And the whole multitude of the people were praying outside at the hour of incense.[11](#) And there appeared to him an angel of the Lord standing on the right side of the altar of incense.[12](#) And Zechariah was troubled when he saw him, and fear fell upon him.[13](#) But the angel said to him, "Do not be afraid, Zechariah, for your prayer has been heard, and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John.[14](#) And you will have joy and gladness, and many will rejoice at his birth,[15](#) for he will be great before the Lord. And he must not drink wine or strong drink, and he will be filled with the Holy Spirit, even from his mother's womb.[16](#) And he will turn many of the

children of Israel to the Lord their God,¹⁷ and he will go before him in the spirit and power of Elijah, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, to make ready for the Lord a people prepared.”
