ARTICLE VII: TERMS, QUALIFICATIONS AND APPOINTMENT OF OFFICERS

Section 1: The term for all officer positions shall be continual, unless or until one of the following occurs: resignation, absenteeism, physical or mental incapacity, moral or financial turpitude, or removal for cause by a two-thirds (2/3) majority of the sitting Board of Trustees.

Section 2: Officers may be a non-government employed taxpayer or a retired or active member of any one of the five pension systems.

Section 3: All Officer Positions are made by appointment by a majority vote of the Board of Trustees.

Section 4: No person shall hold more than one position on the Board at the same time.
