WILLIAM O. ZIEGLER, Elk-  
ton — Mr. Ziegler, 92, founder  
and former operator many years  
of a lumber and tile company  
in Elkton, died Sunday in Hub-  
bard Memorial Hospital, Bad  
Axe. Born Aug. 20, 1870, at  
St. Jacobs, Ont., he came in 1892  
to Elkton. He was the youngest  
and last survivor of a family of  
10 children. He served on the  
Elkton Village Council and  
board of education. He was a  
member of Trinity Lutheran  
Church. He and Miss Barbara  
Soehner were married in 1893.  
She died in 1937. Mr. Ziegler is  
survived by three daughters,  
Mrs. Elizabeth Storbeck, Li-  
vononia, and Mrs. Lena Roberts  
and Mrs. Esther Hodapp, both  
of Elkton; eight grandchildren  
and 16 great-grandchildren. Re-
