- All flat art must be framed. Canvases must be framed or edge painted. Pieces must be wired for hanging.
- The Gallery will install the exhibit and artists must not add or alter it in any way. No art may be removed before the end of the exhibit.
- Pieces may be submitted for sale. No prices may be displayed on the art or walls, but a price list will be available on the entry table.
- Purchases will be between the artist and the buyer. The Lakeville Public Library will not be responsible for sales.
- There is no entry fee. Artists are requested to donate 10% of any sales to the Great Ponds Gallery.

Artist Agreement

I agree to follow the rules of the Patty McMahon Memorial Group Art Exhibit. I understand the Great Ponds Gallery is also a public meeting room and that the Lakeville Public Library offers no security or liability against theft or damage.
