VOP Board of Directors Letter

There's nothing quite like Springtime in VOP! As the flowers and green return, so do the many events that make our neighborhood so special. Coming up again this year you will be able to enjoy our Easter festivities,

the annual Fishing Rodeo, and our one-of-a-kind 4th of July and Harvest celebrations. Make sure to check the calendar so you don't miss one of your favorites.

We kick off the season with our Spring Yard Sale on April 2nd, then move quickly to what has become a VOP favorite, SOD SHARE on April 9th. Make sure to check out details in the separate article. Joining SOD SHARE this year will be our effort to beautify VOP and everyone's yards by adding TREE SHARE, a joint effort with a great local nursery Congaree & Penn. If you've been wanting to add a tree to your landscape, this is just the incentive to get it done. Spring is also the time to take a close look at your yard. If weeds have become the dominant green in your landscape, it's time to take action! As always, getting ahead of them is key, especially if you have dollar weed. Dollar weed can take over your yard and cost you a great deal of money if you don't address it early. We suggest you contact a professional lawn company to give you a hand. Then if you find yourself with some rough areas in your lawn, make sure to take advantage of SOD SHARE. Whether it's just a need for a few pieces or a more significant area, SOD SHARE can help. We can provide up to two palettes of sod (delivered for free directly to your house!)

Exciting Changes Coming: As we announced at the annual meeting in November, we have some exciting plans to add to the value of our neighborhood. During the coming 12-14 months we will be making some noticeable upgrades to our amenity center. Those upgrades include a complete refresh of our structures (painting and re-shingling), adding to our landscaping within the amenity center (including adding Queen Palms), and in time for summer of 2023, doing a complete makeover of our pool furniture. It will truly be an amenity center that we can all really enjoy! In addition, realtors tell us that the upgraded look will add value to the homes selling in VOP.

Block Captains: For those of you who have been around VOP for awhile, you might remember the days when we had Block Captains. These volunteers were in charge of communicating important information to their neighbors and leading the creation of community building events on their streets. The idea slowly faded away as fewer and fewer people were willing to step up and lead.
