June's Meeting Minutes:

Seneschal's Report: Honorable Lady Aesa reported that her quarterly report was submitted. She also congratulates those that have gotten awards lately - Kingdom and Baronial.

Chatelaine Report: Lady Wynne reported Windy Tuesdays have had two "Sit and Stitch" as well as two classes. There has been 12 - 16 members with 6-7 new contacts. She also gave an update on Art After Dark which will be listed under old business.

Exchequer Report: Hilde Steward reported that at Crown, they didn't have trifold pamphlets and asked for more to be printed for the future. The Chatelaine mentioned that she was working on wording for the printing. The funds below have changed as the thrown weapons materials have come in.
