Children and Heatstroke

Did you know that young children are particularly at risk for heatstroke because their bodies heat up three to five times faster than an adults?

Reduce the number of deaths from heatstroke by remembering to ACT.

• <u>Avoid</u> heatstroke-related injury and death by never leaving a child alone in a car, not even for a minute. And make sure to keep your car locked when you're not inside so kids don't get in on their own.

• <u>Create</u> reminders. Keep a stuffed animal or other memento in your child's car seat when it's empty, and move it to the front seat as a visual reminder when your child is in the back seat.

Or place and secure your phone, briefcase or purse in the backseat when traveling with your child.

- <u>Take action</u>. If you see a child alone in a car, call 911. Emergency personnel want you to call. They are trained to respond to these situations
