## **PUBLIC MEETING – HOMEOWNERS HEARING MINUTES**

**The continuation of the Barrington Township Board of Trustees' Homeowners Hearing on the Revised Alternative Project Plan in the unincorporated area met on Wednesday, May 30, 2018, at the Barrington Township Office, located at 602 South Hough Street, Barrington, Illinois.**

**Supervisor Nykaza called the hearing to order at 7:10pm.**

**REVISED ALTERNATIVE PROJECT PLAN PRESENTED: Mr. Brian Valleskey presented a revised alternative project plan, Version #3, that included engineering input from Manhard Consulting to bring clarity and feasibility to the alternate plan under consideration. The presentation focused on residents input, continuity of planned objectives and public safety issues.**

**QUESTIONS FROM THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES: Trustee Gohl asked whether the residents could recall when the flooding issue became more critical within the affected area. No specific timeframe was stated but it appeared that the issue had increased as a result of more building and less permeable land in the region.**

**QUESTIONS FROM THE PUBLIC: Some residents asked whether the flooding conditions would percolate faster under the revised alternative plan proposal. Issues such as the aforementioned were addressed by Manhard Consulting to bring clarity to the project alternative. Resident Ms. Natalie Karney (South Barrington Septic Engineer) spoke in support of the alternative project plan as the best solution to meet the flooding issue within that area of the community.**

**OBJECTORS PRESENTATION:** Some residents, directly impacted by the project, addressed the Board with concerns about the alternative plan's long-term feasibility.

**QUESTIONS FROM THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:** No additional comments or questions were presented.

**QUESTIONS FROM THE PUBLIC:** The residents in attendance asked what procedures needed to be addressed in order to move the project forward. It was stated that the alternative project plan would need the approval of the Township Board. If passed, the project would go out for construction bids and Cook County approvals. It was estimated that the alternative project plan would take approximately two to three months to complete. No additional questions were presented.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** Additional comments focused on future issues that did not directly relate to the alternative project plan under review.

**CLOSE HEARING:** The public portion of the Public Hearing was closed at 8:13pm.

**DISCUSSION, DELIBERATION, AND VOTE ON THE ALTERNATIVE PROJECT PLAN:** The Board tabled its discussion and deliberation on the issues presented regarding the merits of the proposed alternative project plan until its regular scheduled Board Meeting in June.

**ADJOURNMENT:** With no further business to be conducted, the Public Hearing adjourned at 8:25pm.
