### We have a fun week planned!

The tour will start on Sunday, July 17, with an opening lunch and car show at the world famous Jungle Jim's International Market. That evening there will be an ice cream social and fashion show. Daily driving tours will take you to the most scenic, historic, unique - and our most favorite - places in the area. Every morning will start with a stop on the Butler County Donut Trail. Drive your Model T along shaded country roads to historic museums, local farms, and unique towns, and see one-of-a-kind sights. A mid-day 'chat and chew' (lunch!) is included in daily routes.

Highlights of the week include:

- On Monday, enjoy a country drive through the covered bridges of Preble County and see a locally built car
- Tuesday's tour will include a country ride to the Model T Museum in Richmond, IN. Have your car ready for an evening ride to the local drive-in theater.
