Dr. Reid is a Professor of Rehabilitation Counseling at Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) in Richmond, VA. Courses she teaches include those focused on research, evaluation, and life care planning, for the Rehabilitation and Mental Health Counseling master's degree and Health-Related Sciences Ph.D. programs at VCU. She has been the project director for multiple federal grants. Dr. Reid has over 30 years of experience in rehabilitation counseling education, research, and professional practice. Her publications and national/international presentations focus primarily on life care planning, vocational analysis, rehabilitation counseling research, and disability discrimination. As a founding member of the Foundation for Life Care Planning Research (FLCPR), she served in leadership roles with that group for fifteen years, and was honored with a lifetime achievement award from the International Symposium on Life Care Planning. She has served in other leadership roles on national boards such as the Commission on Rehabilitation Counselor Certification and the Council on Rehabilitation Education, as well as professional organizations such as the National Rehabilitation Counseling Association. Her private practice includes life care planning and vocational analysis, as well as consultation to develop and implement rehabilitation research, education, and certification or accreditation programs.
