

RICHARD "DICK" MILTON

1923 - 1989

Richard James "Dick" Milton, age 65 of Colfax Township, passed away Wednesday, May 3 at Huron Memorial Hospital, Bad Axe.

He was born Sept. 17, 1923 in Colfax Township, son of the late James and Alice (Nutt) Milton.

He married Ruth May on Sept. 16, 1950 in Port Huron.

Mr. Milton farmed in Colfax Township for 10 years, then was employed as a custodian for the Elkton-Pigeon-Bay Port School District for 20 years, retiring in January, 1987.

Mr. Milton was a member of Cross Lutheran Church, Pigeon and the Elkton Veterans of Foreign Wars. He was a World War II veteran, serving in the European Theater.

He is survived by his wife, Ruth, Bad Axe; one son, Dave Milton, Elkton; one daughter, Nancy R. Milton, Kalamazoo; several nieces and nephews; one brother, Floyd Milton, Carsonville and one sister, Mrs. Thomas (Irene) Swoffer, Port Huron.

Funeral services were conducted Friday, May 5 at Cross Lutheran Church. The Rev. Raymond E. Orth, pastor, officiated with burial in the church cemetery.
