Bylaw Enforcement

The Bylaw Enforcement Officer will continue to work on main areas of concern for the town, traffic enforcement, animal control and untidy properties. If the complaint or concern is a valid violation of the Town's Bylaws, the Town may issue warnings, orders, or fines to enforce the Bylaws. If this does not solve the issue, Bylaw violations are taken to Provincial Court for further action. If this is required, the person who submitted the complaint may be summoned to Court to testify to the bylaw violation. The Town would like to advise everyone that a lot of effort and resources are put into Bylaw Enforcement and should the complainants not be willing to follow through on the process, the Town's Bylaw Enforcement becomes ineffective.
