K Of C Meeting of May 10, 2023

NOTE: The meeting was opened in council hall with prayer by Grand Knight Julian Rios. Meeting attended by 28 members in good standing. All members present reviewed the minutes, as recorded by Recording Secretary SK David Heilman, of the April 12, 2023 meeting. Approved w/motion by PGK Joe Vitale, seconded by Louie Poupard, passed.

Chaplain's Report (Fr. David Burgard): 1.) Happy Spring! We are entering into the second half of the Easter season leading up to Pentecost where we learn from Acts of the early Christians' struggles and joys. Check Apps for daily Mass readings for Luke's writings and Acts of the Apostles. 2.) Continue celebrating the Resurrection and initiation of new members into our faith community with the First Communions and Confirmations of our children. Congratulate the children and their parents--welcome them and ensure they feel connected to our parish family. Behind each child is a family that may feel disconnected, this is an opportunity for evangelization. Don't take our Faith for granted and assume these families are as strong in Faith as we are. 3.) Family of Parishes (FOP) continues to move forward with strategic planning on how best to implement and grow our Faith community with evangelization to all segments of our parish family (internal and external) including children, young adults, divorced, and the sick/elderly who may not be able to receive the sacraments on a regular basis. Sixteen (16) representatives from all (5) parish families have been working with the AOD and Bishop Battersby to develop a list of actions and processes to reach all parishoners. We need everyone's help to institute a change in our culture to better welcome and engage our Faith community. 4.) This culture change requires the interest, care, patience, and involvement of all our parishoners. We will not get it "perfect" at every step, but we will learn and move forward together. 5.) Some of the issues/groups to be addressed include: a.) Another Adoration Chapel, b.) Vocations including religious (priests/deacons/Lay leaders), divorced and single members and those working through annulments (need to feel important and needed). c.) Focus on youth/young adults programs (retention after Confirmation and high school/college Graduation); d.) Seniors who are not able to attend Mass/have physical disabilities; e.) Deeper understanding of our Faith and sacraments in preparation for First Communion, Confirmation, and Marriage, especially followup. f.) We need to better address how best to reach out and re-engage inactive members, especially teens and young adults by working with/through their peers. g.) Improve how we celebrate Mass and worship including music, homilies, and addressing Social Justice and Environmental issues, h.) Make greater effort to incorporate/collaborate change within our (5) parish families. **6.)** We celebrate Pentecost Sunday May 28. You may choose to pray a Novena 5/19-5/27 and also concentrate in your prayers on the "Fruits of the Spirit". Pick (3) to concentrate on growing and incorporating into your daily routine/activities. 7.) May is the month we dedicate to our Mother Mary. "Salve Regina" is an ancient prayer recognizing and honoring the special place Mary has in our Church and our lives. Pray the rosary and ask for our Mother's guidance until we see Face to Face "What we believe and take in Faith" when we reach "...at the hour of our death".
