### **SUMMER SIZZLE 2019**

The tournament hosted 133 archers representing 20 Archery Clubs and 3 countries.

One National Record was confirmed to be broken. Congratulations to Paseo Vista Archery's Gary Yamaguchi!

The tournament started out, in 2012, as a single day 48 archer tournament shot in one day; and we were told it were never be successful because we were shooting indoors during the outdoor season. This small 25 Meter/18 Meter tournament has grown to be shot over 3 days with potential for even more growth. The Summer Sizzle is one of the few 25M/18M tournaments in the world.

Starting Friday evening August 4<sup>th</sup>, our first group of archers arrived at the Ben Avery Shooting Facility in Phoenix, Arizona. The Ben Avery Indoor Range is the host to the Arizona State Indoor and the Arizona JOAD Indoor. It has 13 bales in the building and comfortably seats all the archers and their guests during the tournament. This is the first tournament after Desert Sky Archers installed the new 100 watt spot lights, one for each bale. Electronic timing was handled by a laptop and two computer monitors down range easy for all archers to see.

Desert Sky strives to bring top quality tournaments at a state level to all the archers that compete. DSA would like to thank all of its team members for their hard work and dedication to the club and our sport.
