Coach Lou has been an integral part of the River Dell community for over 59 years, coaching and mentoring athletes across multiple generations. His dedication to the development of student-athletes extends across parts of seven decades, from the 1960s to the 2020s (1966 – Present). During his tenure, he coached not only track and field but also wrestling and football, consistently fostering teamwork, discipline, and perseverance in every athlete.

Throughout his career, Coach Lou has been recognized for his extraordinary contributions, including being named **River Dell MS Teacher of the Year** and **County Coach of the Year for Indoor Girls Track** in 1973 as an assistant coach. His leadership in wrestling earned him a place in the **Region 2 Wrestling Hall of Fame**, and his teams in the early 1970s were champions, winning **State Sectional**, **District**, and **League titles** in 1972 and 1973.

As a coach, Lou has touched countless lives, leading both boys and girls to excel in various sports. His remarkable coaching career is complemented by his own accomplishments as a **three-sport athlete** in high school, where he earned letters in **Football**, **Wrestling**, and **Track**. Lou continued his athletic career at **Montclair State**, where he played football for a year and wrestled for two before a knee injury ended his competitive career.

Beyond the field and track, Coach Lou is a true family man. His love and devotion to his late wife, Frances, his 3 children, and 9 grandchildren are at the heart of who he is. He speaks of them often and with great pride, and his commitment to family mirrors the care and dedication he's shown to his athletes throughout the years.

This meet is a tribute to Coach Lou's exceptional contributions to River Dell athletics and his unwavering commitment to the success of our student athletes. It is a perfect opportunity to honor him while showcasing the talent of our novice throwers.
