Don Phillips age 74 of Caseville died Wednesday morning, November 9, at Bay Medical Center, Bay City.

He was born December 2, 1919 in South Fork PA son of the late William and Catherine Lewis) Phillips.

On August 12, 1943, he was united in marriage to Mary Mulhearn in Lilly, PA.
