

Onsite Learning and Support Services Plan

Beginning August 17, 2020, in compliance with Executive Orders 2020-41 and 2020-51, Destiny School will be making on-site support services available at the Destiny School Campus to all students requiring special support, including special education, English language learners, and those residing in foster care settings.

Our Special Education Director, Mrs. Palmer, will be contacting each family of our special needs students individually to determine what is appropriate for each student.

Additionally, beginning August 17, 2020, on-site learning and monitoring at the Destiny School Campus will be available for students that have nowhere else to go. Students will be supervised by para-professional staff members while they participate in distance learning classes.

The parents/guardians of every enrolled student will be contacted by telephone and informed of the availability of on-site learning and support services. Letters will also be sent to each home and the information will be posted on the school website prior to August 17, 2020.

On-site learning and support services will be available Monday through Thursday from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm excluding Holidays and breaks. This is the same days and hours that students attended school last year.

Students in attendance will be expected to do the following:

- Check in with their name, school, and teacher's name with the staff member at the entrance
- Participate in daily health screening(s)
- Wear a mask at all times, unless they are eating/drinking
- Remain in their assigned seat and follow staff member directions
- Sign into their distance learning classroom and participate in distance learning independently according to their class schedule without disrupting other students
- Have breaks for breakfast / lunch / water and to use the restroom. If the student typically pays for lunch, and wishes to purchase one, they will need to have the money to do so. (meals are not provided for free unless your student qualifies for free meals)
- Adhere to Board policies and Student Handbook expectations.

It is important to know that this is not 'school'. Certified teachers will not be supervising students. All instruction, including services for students that are learning English as a second language and for students with Individualized Education Plans, will be provided online via distance learning. Participating students will be expected to be present Monday-Thursday, 8:00am - 3:00pm.

We are not able to provide transportation at this time. Parents/guardians will be responsible for student transportation.

Due to staffing constraints and safety limitations involved in monitoring students outside the school setting, parents/guardians must be aware of the following limitations:

- Students that are disruptive or that present signs of illness must be picked up immediately by their parent/guardian. They will be required to participate in distance learning from home.
- If a student is picked up late or dropped off early, they will need to participate in distance learning from home.
