Mat 22:37 Jesus said to him, You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.

Mat 22:38 This is the first and great commandment.

Mat 22:39 And the second *is* like it, You shall love your neighbor as yourself.

Mat 22:40 On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets.

Rom 10:9 Because if you confess the Lord Jesus, and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from *the* dead, you shall be saved.

Rom 10:10 For with *the* heart *one* believes unto righteousness, and with *the* mouth *one* confesses unto salvation.

Rom 10:11 For the Scripture says, "Everyone believing on Him shall not be put to shame."

Rom 10:12 For there is no difference both of Jew and of Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call on Him.

Rom 10:13 For everyone, "whoever shall call on the name of *the* Lord will be saved."

Mat 5:3 Blessed *are* the poor in spirit! For theirs is the kingdom of Heaven.

Mat 5:4 Blessed *are* they that mourn! For they shall be comforted.

Mat 5:5 Blessed *are* the meek! For they shall inherit the earth.

Mat 5:6 Blessed *are* they who hunger and thirst after righteousness! For they shall be filled.

Mat 5:7 Blessed *are* the merciful! For they shall obtain mercy.

Mat 5:8 Blessed *are* the pure in heart! For they shall see God.

Mat 5:9 Blessed *are* the peacemakers! For they shall be called the sons of God.

Mat 5:10 Blessed *are* they who have been persecuted for righteousness sake! For theirs is the kingdom of Heaven.

Mat 5:11 Blessed are you when *men* shall revile you and persecute *you*, and shall say all kinds of evil against you falsely, for My sake.

Mat 5:12 Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for your reward in Heaven *is* great. For so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

Mat 5:44 But I say to you, Love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you,

Mat 6:6 But you, when you pray, enter into your room. And shutting your door, pray to your Father in secret; and your Father who sees in secret shall reward you openly.

Mat 6:25 Therefore I say to you, Do not be anxious for your life, what you shall eat, or what you shall drink; nor for your body, what you shall put on. Is not life more than

food, and the body more than clothing?

Mat 6:26 Behold the birds of the air; for they sow not, nor do they reap, nor gather into barns. Yet your heavenly Father feeds them; are you not much better than they are?

Mat 6:28 And why are you anxious about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow. They do not toil, nor do they spin,

Mat 6:30 Therefore if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, *will He* not much rather *clothe* you, little-faiths?

Mat 6:31 Therefore do not be anxious, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, With what shall we be clothed?

Mat 6:34 Therefore do not be anxious about tomorrow; for tomorrow shall be anxious for its own things. Sufficient to the day *is* the evil of it.

Mar 13:7 And when you shall hear *of* wars and rumors of wars, do not be troubled. For it must happen, but the end *shall not be* yet.

Luk 12:28 If then God so clothes the grass (which today *is* in the field, and tomorrow is cast into the oven) how much more *will He clothe* you, O little-faiths?

Luk 18:20 You know the commandments: Do not commit adultery, do not kill, do not steal, do not bear false witness, honor your father and your mother.

Joh 14:27 Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Rom 12:14 Bless those who persecute you; bless, and do not curse.

Rom 12:21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good

Rom 13:9 For: "Do not commit adultery; do not murder; do not steal; do not bear false witness; do not lust;" and if *there is* any other commandment, it is summed up in this word, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

Heb 3:13 But exhort one another daily, while it is called today, lest any of you be hardened through *the* deceitfulness of sin.

2Co 4:1 Therefore since we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we do not faint.

2Co 4:16 For this cause we do not faint; but though our outward man perishes, yet the inward *man* is being renewed day by day

2Co 6:14 Do not be unequally yoked together *with* unbelievers; for what fellowship does righteousness *have* with lawlessness? And what partnership does light *have* with darkness?

2Co_6:17 Therefore come out from among them and be separated, says the Lord, and do not touch the unclean *thing*. And I will receive you

Eph_6:12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the world's rulers, of the darkness of this age, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

Php_4:6 Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God.

Col_3:23 And whatever you do, do *it* heartily, as to the Lord and not to men;

1Th_5:19 Do not quench the (*Holy*) Spirit.

1Th_5:20 Do not despise prophesying.

2Th_3:13 But you, brothers, do not be weary in well doing.

1Ti_5:8 But if anyone does not provide for *his* own, and especially *his* family, he has denied the faith and is worse than an infidel.

Jas_5:12 But before all things, my brothers, do not swear; neither by the heaven nor by the earth, nor any other oath. But let your yes be yes, and *your* no, no, lest you fall into condemnation.
