

Imagard I Sorensen

1919 - 2007

Irmagard Ida Sorensen, age 88 of Pigeon passed away Saturday September 15 at her home. She was born in Detroit on February 21, 1919 and was the daughter of the late William and Irma (Weder) Scholz. She graduated from Wayne State University, Detroit in 1941 as a teacher. On April 24, 1943 she was united in marriage to Dr. Maurice Sorensen in Detroit. He preceded her in death on March 9, 1992. After marriage she and Dr. Sorensen moved to Levenworth, Kansas and later practiced medicine and lived in Kinde, Bad Axe and Detroit prior to moving to Elkton where she assisted her husband as he established his medical practice in 1957 until Dr. Sorensen retired in 1984. She was a member of Cross Lutheran Church, Pigeon and the Cross Lutheran Church Women.

She is survived by her three children Dr. Kent Sorensen; Dr. Philip and Jackie Sorensen Grand Rapids; and Ingrid and Dr. Galen Ebert, Imlay City; three grandsons Derek Sorensen, Christopher and Eric Ebert; two nieces and three nephews. She was preceded in death by a brother William Scholz.
