Holy Scripture

RESPONSIVE READING - *Psalm 110.1-7*

Happy are those whose transgression is forgiven,
whose sin is covered.

***Happy are those to whom the LORD imputes no iniquity,
and in whose spirit there is no deceit.***

While I kept silence, my body wasted away
through my groaning all day long.

***For day and night Your hand was heavy upon me;
my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer.***

Then I acknowledged my sin to You,
and I did not hide my iniquity;

***I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord,"
and You forgave the guilt of my sin.***

Therefore let all who are faithful offer prayer to You;
at a time of distress the rush of mighty waters shall not reach them.

***You are a hiding place for me; You preserve me from trouble;
You surround me with glad cries of deliverance.***

EPISTLE READING - *Romans 6.15-23*

What then? Should we sin because we are not under law but under grace? By no means! Do you not know that if you present yourselves to anyone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin, which leads to death, or of obedience, which leads to righteousness? But thanks be to God that you, having once been slaves of sin, have become obedient from the heart to the form of teaching to which you were entrusted, and that you, having been set free from sin, have become slaves of righteousness. I am speaking in human terms because of your

natural limitations; for just as you once presented your members as slaves to impurity and to greater and greater iniquity, so now present your members as slaves to righteousness for sanctification. When you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. So what advantage did you then get from the things of which you now are ashamed? The end of those things is death. But now that you have been freed from sin and enslaved to God, the advantage you get is sanctification. The end is eternal life. For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

GOSPEL LESSON - *Matthew 13.36-43*

Then [Jesus] left the crowds and went into the house and His disciples approached Him, saying, "Explain to us the parable of the weeds of the field." He answered, "The one who sows the good seed is the Son of Man; the field is the world, and the good seed are the children of the kingdom; the weeds are the children of the evil one, and the enemy who sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are angels. Just as the weeds are collected and burned up with fire, so will it be at the end of the age. The Son of Man will send His angels and they will collect out of His Kingdom all causes of sin and all evildoers and they will [be thrown] into the furnace of fire, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the Kingdom of their Father. Let anyone with ears listen!"

This is the Word of the Lord!
