GM is reportedly tweaking its assembly lines at Bowling Green in an effort to accommodate C8 Corvette Grand Sport production.

The Grand Sport name is a legendary one within the illustrious history of the Corvette, having debuted <u>as a factory-built racer</u> in 1963 that was ultimately built in scant quantities and is worth a fortune today, after which it <u>returned in 1996</u> as what was essentially an appearance package – albeit, a popular one. The <u>C6</u> and <u>C7</u> Grand Sport Corvettes took things a bit further by basically splitting the performance difference between the Z06 and ZR1, making it a favorite for budget conscious shoppers that love the looks of those models, yet don't necessarily need something that hardcore. Now, we may very well be on the verge of seeing a C8 Corvette Grand Sport added to the lineup, too.

Rumors that a C8 Corvette Grand Sport was in development have swirled for a very long time now, and this past December, a prototype was spotted that looked very much precisely like that, with a wide body, no rear spoiler, and the same exhaust setup as the Stingray. Now, in this new video from **Rick Conti**, he discusses rumors that the Bowling Green Assembly Plant is being retooled as we speak for C8 Corvette Grand Sport production, too.

Harlan Charles Career with Corvette, GM Ends After 37 Years




General Motors has a lost another key member of its Corvette Team after notifying Corvette Product Marketing Manager <u>Harlan Charles</u> that "his time was up." Harlan confirmed his retirement from GM on his <u>Facebook page</u> late Sunday evening, thanking those he worked with and while also looking back on his accomplishments with America's Favorite Sports Car.

Harlan joined General Motors 37 years ago and has been on the Corvette team for 24 of those years. He was known for his rapport with Corvette owners as well as taking on the GM establishment to produce the mid-engine C8 Corvette. His presence at Corvette events will be missed. He follows retired Corvette Chief Engineer Tadge Juecther, who left the company in July 2024 after a 47 year career with the company.

Surviving Uncertainty Part 1: The C5 Corvette

The C5 Corvette coupe joined the decadeslong lineage of Corvette in 1997.

It might be difficult to imagine today, but there was a period during one of General Motors' more challenging financial eras that nearly saw the deliberate discontinuation of the Corvette – the C5 Corvette in particular – long before its eventual arrival in the final years of the twentieth century.














TICKETS NOW ON SALE FOR CTMP'S 2025 MAJOR EVENTS


