Pakistan frees captured Indian pilot Abhinandan in peace gesture

Indian Air Force (IAF) Wing Commander Abhinandan — who was captured by Pakistan after his MiG 21 Bison aircraft was shot down by a Pakistan Air Force (PAF) jet — was handed over in a gesture of peace to India at the Wagah border.

He was filmed walking across the Wagah pavilion at around 9pm in civilian clothes.

The pilot was accompanied to the border by the International Committee of the Red Cross, reported the Associated Press. His handover took several hours as a roster of procedures were completed including a medical checkup to verify his health and condition before being handed over to his countrymen.

Abhinandan was arrested on Feb 27 after his aircraft was shot down by the PAF upon violating Pakistani airspace. the statement.

"I am a fighter pilot in the Indian Air Force. I was in search of the target when your [Pakistan] Air Force shot me down. I had to eject the plane which had sustained damage. As soon as I ejected and when my parachute opened and when I fell down, I had a pistol with me."

"There were many people. I had only one way to save myself: I dropped my pistol and tried to run," he was heard saying in the video. "People chased me, their emotions were running high. Just then, two Pakistani Army officials came and saved me. Pakistani army captains saved from the people and did not let any harm come to me. They took me to their unit where I was administered first aid and then I was taken to the hospital where I further underwent a medical exam and received more aid," he said.

"The Pakistan Army is a very professional service. I see peace in it. I have spent time with the Pakistan Army [and] I am very impressed."

"Indian media always stretches the truth," he regretted. "The smallest of things are presented in a very incendiary manner and people get misled."



China welcomes Pakistan 'goodwill signal'

China said it welcomes the "goodwill signal" by Pakistan in releasing captured Indian Air Force pilot Abhinandan Varthaman as a gesture of peace. Wing Commander Varthaman returned to India, a day after Pakistan Prime Minister Imran Khan announced that the pilot would be released "in our desire for peace".

In the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' briefing, China's Foreign Ministry spokesperson Lu Kang said that China had, from the beginning, called upon both sides to exercise restraint, ease tensions, and engage in dialogue. "China welcomes the goodwill signal by the Pakistan side. De-escalation serves common interest of both sides," Lu said. "Encourage both sides to make a joint effort to deal with the relevant issue."

He reiterated that China hopes to see regional peace and stability. China Daily, the state-owned English-language daily newspaper, in its editorial headlined 'India, Paki-stan need to rein in their animosity', stated: "As a good neighbour of both Pakistan and India, China, in particular, has expressed "deep concern" over the situation, urging the two arch-rivals to "exercise restraint" and resolve their dispute through dialogue." It noted that "nationalistic hysteria" is on the "rise in both countries", and that leaders of both India and Pakistan "will have to work hard to ensure they are not hijacked by the mood of the public, especially after tit-for-tat airstrikes in which both sides claimed they shot down each other's fighter jets and the Pakistanis said they captured at least one Indian pilot". The editorial reiterated Beijing's stance on respecting the sovereignty of a country's territory. Critiquing India, it stated, "The anger over the heavy casualties is understandable. But using warplanes to bomb targets deep inside another sovereign



Humans are always fascinated by the origin and movements of the Sun, Earth, Moon, Planets, and stars. Many cultures developed many interesting mythological stories in the past. In this article, we are going to discuss the questions such as Why the moon is not falling on the Earth? Why Earth is not falling on the sun? Why planets are revolving elliptical around the sun?

For the readers with little time, the quick scientific answer is "Earth keeps falling onto Sun due to the gravity but keeps missing it due to its speed and trajectory."

In the past, humans came up with creative imaginations about the movement of the Sun and planets. They were very remarkable with many ideas and mythological stories. In the Hindu Puranas, the Sun God circumnavigates mount Himalayas every day. Vindhya mountains of India grew taller, obstructed the Sun path and caused problems to Gods and humans. Later obeyed to sage Agastya's words and stopped growing. According to one Hindu myth, eclipse happens when Rahu dragon's' head swallows the Sun. Hanuman in his childhood mistaking Sun for fruit and trying to eat it. At the same time, Rahu was trying to swallow Sun for the eclipse.

Hearing this Lord Indra got angry, stuck Hanuman child with his Vajra weapon and made the child unconscious. Ravan, in Ramayana, had defeated all the Devas and had brought all the Grahas (planets in astrology) under his control. Once he kept all the planets suppressed beneath his leg.

In Egyptian culture, Sun God Ra at night returned to the east via the underworld and reborn each day. This reflects the typical Egyptian idea of immortality. In Greek legend, the Apollo, rode a chariot pulled by fiery horses across the sky and gives the light to the world. In the Chinese tale, ten suns caused too much heat in the past, so the emperor Dijun sent the archer Yi to shoot all suns and leaving only one. The Aztecs believed their sun God, requires blood from the human heart for his survival and they offered human sacrifice.

Few hundred years ago, Galileo faced Roman inquisition and indefinite house arrest by Pope Urban VIII for saying the Earth is revolving around the sun. The Book of Genesis states that the planet Earth was created three days before the sun, moon, and stars and originally favored the geocentric model. His telescopic observations favored the heliocentric model and conflicted with the teachings of the powerful Roman Catholic Church.

Now let us discuss in terms of science. The question Newton asked was "Why doesn't the Moon fall toward the Earth?" This was a fascinating scientific question of his day when no one had previously asked such questions.

Newton was convinced that the planets must follow the same physical laws observed on Earth. Newton's law of universal gravitation states that the gravitational force between any two objects is proportional to the product of their masses and inversely proportional to the square of the distance between them. In the laboratory, if you hang two heavy balls with a long wire, you can observe balls come close due to the gravitational attraction between them. Distances are shorter at the bottom of the wire than at the top.

According to Newton's first law, planets/ objects in motion stay in motion. For example, if you release swing high in the playground, it rides down due to gravity. But it does not stop once it reaches the middle, it moves all the way up to another side. Why? Because objects in motion stay in motion according to Newtons's first law. It swings back again and again till it



completely stops. Now you push with a little twist on the swing, it moves in

with a little twist on the swing, it moves in circular motion. If there is no friction and no air, the swing can continue to rotate around for a very long time. Gravity acts like the rope which keeps attracting the Earth to the sun but the sideways speed of the planets keep them balanced in the circular orbits. Earth is go-ing sideways faster and keeps missing the sun like a twisted swing moves the circular or elliptical motion. Moon is also falling or elliptical motion. Moon is also falling onto Earth continuously but keeps missing the Earth.

Earth is moving around the sun for a few billion years and will continue for billions of years. If the Sun's gravitation is not strong enough, the Earth might escape. Modern observations also suggest that the moon is moving away from Earth by 1.6 inches per year as Earth rotation is slowing.

I am sure you will have many questions than answers such as Why Earth's orbit not circular?, How/When did the Earth put into its orbit originally? And What are the gravitational influence of the Sun, Moon, Planets, and Stars on Earth?

Saudi Arabia names first woman envoy to Washington at critical time

Khartoum (AFP) - Sudanese President Omar al-Bashir swore in a new premier Sunday as riot police confronted hundreds of demonstrators calling on the veteran leader to resign Saudi Arabia named a princess as its first woman ambassador to the United States, a key appointment as the fallout over journalist Jamal Khashoggi's murder tests relations between the allies.

Princess Rima bint Bandar replaced Prince Khalid bin Salman, the younger brother of the powerful crown prince who was appointed vice defence minister in a flurry of late-night royal decrees announced on state media.

The reshuffle comes as Saudi Arabia seeks to quell an international outcry over Khashoggi's murder last October in the Saudi consulate in Istanbul, which strained relations with its key ally Washington.

After initially denying they knew anything of Khashoggi's disappearance, the kingdom finally acknowledged that Saudi agents killed him inside the consulate, but described it as a rogue operation.

Princess Rima faces hostile US lawmakers who have threatened tough action against Saudi Arabia over the brutal killing amid claims that Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman -- the kingdom's de-facto ruler -- was personally responsible.

The Saudi government has denied he had anything to do with the murder of Khashoggi, a royal insider-turnedcritic who was a columnist with the Washington Post.

"The appointment of a new envoy signifies an attempt by Riyadh to try and re-set relations with Washington and draw a line under the Khashoggi affair, however unlikely that may be in practice, at least with Congress," Kristian Ulrichsen, a fellow at Rice University's Baker Institute in the United States, told AFP.

- 'First female ambassador' -

Princess Rima, the daughter of a former long-time ambassador to the US, has been a leading advocate of female

criticism over the recent jailing of women activists -- and subsequent claims of sexual abuse and torture of some of them in detention.

The princess previously worked at the kingdom's General Sports Authority, where she led a campaign to increase women's participation in sports.

"Princess Rima becomes the first female ambassador in Saudi history and the first female with a rank of minister -- a strong signal to the integration of women into the government and workforce," Ali Shihabi, founder of the pro-Saudi think-tank Arabia Foundation, said on Twitter.

Prince Khalid, a son of the king who served as ambassador since 2017, had been expected to leave Washington for some time -- particularly after the global outcry over Khashoggi tarnished the kingdom's reputation.

His new appointment as deputy defence minister comes as a military coalition led by Saudi Arabia remains bogged down in a four-year conflict in neighbouring Yemen.

A separate royal decree on Saturday ordered a one-month salary bonus for frontline military officials on the kingdom's southern border.

- 'Difficult portfolio' -

Prince Khalid, a former Saudi air force pilot, takes his post a year after the crown prince -- who also serves as the defence minister -- announced a military reform plan and a dramatic overhaul of top defence commanders.

"As the Yemen war drags on and the military reform programme continues to move painstakingly slow, Prince Khalid is gaining a difficult portfolio but one that is critical to his father, brother and the kingdom," Becca Wasser, a policy analyst at the US-based RAND Corporation, told AFP.



"Prince Mohammed has struggled to delegate authority within this file which has rendered some efforts ---chiefly military reform -- stagnant, and Prince Khalid's appointment may be an attempt to reinvigorate these initiatives."

Shihabi said Prince Khalid will virtually have the same authority as the defence minister, shouldering some of the burden on the crown prince.

Khashoggi's killing has refocused attention on the Saudiled coalition's bombing campaign in Yemen, which is gripped by what the UN calls the world's worst humanitarian crisis.

A key challenge for Princess Rima will be to win over US lawmakers, who earlier this month voted overwhelmingly to end American involvement in the Saudi war effort in Yemen, dealing a rebuke to President Donald Trump who has publicly thrown his support behind the crown prince.

US lawmakers this month also said they were probing whether Trump was rushing to sell sensitive nuclear technology to Saudi Arabia, voicing fears that it could be misused to make an atomic bomb.







New Sudan PM sworn in amid protests against state of emergency

Khartoum (AFP) - Sudanese President Omar al-Bashir swore in a new premier as riot police confronted hundreds of demonstrators calling on the veteran leader to resign after he imposed a state of emergency across the country.

MARCH 2019

Bashir declared a year-long emergency on Friday after a deadly crackdown failed to suppress weeks of protests against his three-decade rule.

The president, who swept to power in an Islamist-backed coup in 1989, dissolved the cabinet and provincial governments, and pledged to bring in technocrats to help end the economic crisis -- the key factor behind the protests.

On Sunday, the former governor of the agricultural state of Jazeera, Mohamed Tahir Eila, was sworn in as the new prime minister at a ceremony, an AFP photographer said.

Defence Minister General Awad Ibnouf was sworn in as the first vice president after his predecessor Bakri Hassan Saleh was sacked by Bashir.

Bashir also swore in 16 army officers and two officers from the National Intelligence and Security Service dressed in military uniforms as new governors for the country's 18 provinces.

"Today, a new chapter begins in Sudan's history," Bashir, dressed in a military uniform, said at the ceremony.

"This chapter needs special people like you to lead... in order to guarantee security and stability in the country."

Bashir is expected to announce an entire new cabinet as he pushes on with sweeping top level changes in the face of nationwide protests that have rocked his rule. 'Message to president' -

Even as the new officials took oath, hundreds of protesters rallied in Omdurman, the twin city of Khartoum, against the state of emergency.

"We want to give the president a message that the state of emergency will not deter us," said Sawsan Bashir who participated in the Omdurman rally.

"Our aim is to overthrow this regime and we will do it." Protesters also demonstrated in the capital's districts of Burri and Shambat, according to witnesses.

Riot police swiftly confronted protesters in Omdurman and Burri with tear gas, witnesses said.

Protest organisers have vowed to continue



with daily rallies, accusing Bashir and his officials of economic mismanagement that has led to soaring food prices and shortage of foreign currency.

Deadly clashes between protesters and security forces have left 31 people dead since protests first erupted on December 19, officials say.

Chicago's Indian Americans stages a huge protest rally in front of Pakistan and Chinese Consulate Office

Chicago IL: With the chants of "Bharat Matha Ki Jai' reverberating on the famed Michigan Avenue corridor, a massive congregation of deeply grieved Indian Americans bearing tricolor Indian and star-spangled American flags with placards of denouncing Pakistan for promoting terrorism - thundered through the famed Michigan Ave corridor with a huge protest rally in front of Pakistan Consulate Office that which shifted to the Chinese Consulate Office in what can be described as the largest rally of the Indian Americans in downtown Chicago on Thursday, February 21, 2019.

With the patriotic fervor spilling over on the sidewalks of Michigan Ave. all the way to the Chinese Consulate Office down a mile away on Erie Street. The slogans and remarks were interspersed with grief and outrage at the dastardly attack on 40 helpless CRPF soldiers who were ambushed with a suicide attack. Dr. Bharat Barai, a prominent Indian American community leader in his remarks welcomed the outpouring support of the Indian Americans gathered on a cold afternoon and thanked them for their unfailing patriotic spirit. Dr. Bharat Barai chastised Pakistan for their continued mayhem with their repeated murderous rampage in Him outlined 5000 years history of India with Kashmir as an epicenter of Religious, Educational, Cultural heritage. After 1947 partition of India, the Maharaja of Jammu and Kashmir signed an instrument of accession with India, ratified by the elected constituent Assembly. He thanked the World powers including USA, UK, France, Russia, many Islamic countries for condemning the Pulwama attack and supporting India. Keerthi Kumar Ravoori said we mourn the loss of life of the soldiers in this deadliest terrorist attack in India and challenged Pakistan government to take proactive measurable actions to snub the scourge of terrorism. From there, the Protesters went to the Chinese Consulate. They showed placards denouncing China's double talk on terrorism. On one side, China denounces all terrorism. On the other side, China has consistently blocked UN Security Council from proscribing the Pakistani terrorist organizations. Lashkar e Taiba and its leader Hafiz Saeed;



Jaish e Muhammed and its leader Masood Azhar have been responsible for many terror attacks including Mumbai terrorist attack killing 176 people and recent Pulwama attack killing 44 people. A memorandum was delivered to the Chinese Consulate.

The protest rally was largely led by among others: Hemant Patel, Nirav Patel, J.D. Digvanker, Shamkanth Sheth, Prasad Yelalmanchi, Amar Upadhyay, Nitin Garg, Pandya, Chirayu Parikh and Amitabh Mittal. Each of them articulated messages that summarized that Pakistan is a hub of terrorism and is constantly manufacturing company of terrorist; while harboring and nurturing them to be a dark men of death. In a statement, Hemant Patel said Terrorism in not only a political issue; it is also an ideological war, which is affecting the entire humanity. The suicide bombers are brainwashed from their infancy, they are fed with hatred against humanity, and these merchants of death are assured of reward in paradise for killing people. Pakistani connection was found in most major terror attacks in the world. A request was made to the Muslim Community to educate and restrain the Jihadi ideology and terrorism.

In an apparent case of 'murder-suicide', an Indian-American couple from Hyderabad was found dead in their home in Texas with gunshot wounds.

However, the couple's 16-year-old daughter, who was also home at the time of the incident escaped the ordeal unhurt.

The couple is also survived by their 21-year-old son, who is studying at the University of Texas. The incident came to light when the couple's neighbors called the cops at around 5.40am on February 18, after hearing gunshots.

When police arrived, they found the wife, 46-year-old Shanti Nakirekanti, dead in the driveway with a gunshot wound to the head.

The husband, 51-year-old Sreenivas, was found dead in the bedroom with a gunshot wound to the chest.

Fact: The couple's daughter was asleep during the incident

The couple's daughter, who was at home during the incident, told police that she had been asleep, and was unaware of what had happened. She is now in the



custody of the family's friends.

Deceased: What we know about the deceased couple Both husband and wife had received their education from the Texas A&M University.

Shanti, an M.S. in computer science from the university, was working as a project lead architect at United Airlines.

Sreenivas, meanwhile, held a Master's degree in mechanical engineering from Texas A&M University, and an MBA from Rice University in Houston, Texas. He was a director at an energy company in Houston.

Investigation: Domestic discord could have led to the incident, police say

A small handgun was retrieved from the bedroom

where it was found lying beside Sreenivas' corpse.

Cops have said that the deaths appear to be a case of 'murder-suicide' wherein Sreenivas shot Shanti before killing himself.

However, the reason behind the murder-suicide is unknown as of now, and the police suspect that it could have been the result of a domestic discord.

Fact: There is no danger to residents: Police

"There is no danger to residents and SLPD is not looking for any suspects. The two fatalities fit the scenario of a murder-suicide. This case is still under investigation," said the Sugar Land Police Department (SLPD) in a press statement.





Hours after the Supreme Court took cognizance of assault on Kashmiri students in the aftermath of Pulwama attack, and directed 11 states to take "prompt" action to prevent such incidents, former Jammu and Kashmir chief ministers Mehbooba Mufti and Omar Abdullah on Friday welcomed the apex court's decision.

The Supreme Court, while hearing a petition on incidents of threat and violence against Kashmiri students today, sought

Following the court's decision, the chief secretaries and DGPs of Maharashtra, Punjab, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jammu and Kashmir, Haryana, Meghalaya, West Bengal, Chhattisgarh and Uttarakhand, and the Delhi Police commissioner have been directed to prevent incidents of "threat, assault and social boycott" of Kashmiris, including students.



A bench headed by Chief Justice of India Ranjan Gogoi also directed that the police officers, who were earlier appointed as nodal officers to deal with lynching incidents, would now be responsible to deal with cases of assaults on Kashmiris.

The bench was hearing a plea of Tariq Adeeb seeking a direction to the Centre and the states to prevent incidents of assaults, threats and social boycott of Kashmiris in the wake of the Pulwama terror attack in which 40 CRPF personnel were killed.

Swami Hansdevacharya, key figure in Ram temple movement dies in road accident

UP Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath and BJP president Amit Shah condoled the demise of Hansdevacharya, who was the leader of the Bairagis campaigning for construction of a Ram temple in Ayodhya at the site where Babri Masjid existed.

The mosque was demolished in December 1992 by karsevaks (volunteers) who had gathered in the UP town following a call given by Vishwa Hindu Parishad and supported by the Bharatiya Janata Party to push for construction of a Ram temple there. The VHP and the BJP have maintained that it was the place where Lord Ram was born.

The Supreme Court is hearing the title suit in the matter after a judgment of the Allahabad High Court was challenged before it. The high court, in 2010, ruled that the disputed land should be divided into three equal parts among three parties including the one repre senting Ram Lalla.

Alabama mother begs to return to US, says moving to Syria and marrying ISIS fighters was 'a big mistake'

With U.S.-backed forces closing in on ISIS in Syria, young mother Hoda Muthana is pleading for a second chance and the opportunity to return home to her family in Alabama.

I realized I've made a big mistake and I know I've ruined my future and my son's future and I deeply, deeply regret it," she said in an interview with The Guardian newspaper. Muthana is one of 1,500 foreign women and children living in a Kurdish-run refugee camp in northern Syria. Muthana's family lawyer, Hassan Shibly, told ABC News the young mother was "brainwashed" by ISIS and now feels "tremendous remorse."

"This is a young, vulnerable woman who was brainwashed and manipulated by monsters who took advantage of her," Shibly said in an interview that airs on "Good Morning America" on Tuesday morning. "Hooda is absolutely disgusted by the person she became while under the spell." In 2017, Muthana's father told ABC News' Diane Sawyer that he'd been proud when she seemed to become more devout about religion. He said he had no idea that she was secretly taking cues from ISIS recruiters sending her messages over the phone.

"I never thought in my life that it would happen to us, to me, to my family, but it happened," he said. "It could happen to any other family."

Muthana, who now has an 18-month-old son, left Alabama four years ago at the age of 19. She spread ISIS propaganda online, calling for attacks on Americans According to AL.com, she tweeted messages encouraging people to "spill American blood."

Now, after surrendering to Kurdish authorities, she told the Guardian that she fears for her safety.

"From what I heard, if they were to read my messages, I would have been killed," she said. Muthana has been married three times to ISIS fighters. Twice, she was made a widow.

In a letter obtained exclusively by ABC News, she described herself as a "naive, angry and arrogant" young woman when she set out for Syria. Muthana said she thought she understood her religious beliefs and had stopped listening to her family.

"That was a big mistake," she said in the letter. "During my years in Syria I would see and experience a way of life and the terrible effects of war which changed me. Seeing bloodshed up close changed me. Motherhood changed me. Seeing friends, children and the men I married dying changed me. Seeing how different a society could be compared to the beloved America I was born and raised into changed me," she said "Being where I was and seeing the ppl around me scared me because I realized I didn't want to be a part of this. My beliefs weren't the same as theirs. In my quiet moments, in between bombings, starvation, cold and fear I would look at my beautiful little boy and know that I didn't belong here and neither did he. I would think sometimes of my family, my friends and the life that I knew and I realized how I didn't appreciate or maybe even really understand how impor-



tant the freedoms that we have in America are. I do now. To say that I regret my past words, any pain that I caused my family and any concerns I would cause my country would be hard for me to really express properly. Muthana is expected to be brought home to face justice, which President Donald Trump has pushed other countries to do as well.

Muthana's family lawyer told ABC News she wants to return to the United States to be "accountable for her choices," and to hopefully be a powerful voice to ensure that others don't repeat the mistakes she made.

"She wants to make amends by doing her best to speak out and ensure that she can protect other young individuals being brainwashed and taken advantage of in the same way she has," Shibly said in the interview on "GMA." "She's willing to risk her life right now to condemn ISIS."

Another wave of retail store closures coming. 'No light at the end of the tunnel'

Already, 2,187 store closures have been announced by retailers in 2019, according to Coresight Research. That stems from names including: Gymboree, J.C. Penney, Charlotte Russe and Ann Taylor parent company Ascena Retail.

Analysts say the U.S. is still "over-stored

Another wave of store closures is expected to hit shopping centers and malls this year with "no light at the end of the tunnel," according to a new research report.

Retailers have already announced 2,187 new store closures since Jan. 1, including Gymboree, J.C. Penney, Charlotte Russe and Ann Taylor parent company Ascena Retail, according to Coresight Research. That's up 23 percent from the number of announcements documented at the same time last year, the market research group said. And there's "potentially many more on the way due to companies currently in the bankruptcy process and more on the horizon."

In 2018, Coresight tracked 5,524 store closure announcements in the U.S., which was down more than 30 percent from a record 8,139 closures announced in 2017. David Simon, CEO of the largest mall operator in the U.S., Simon Property Group, recently said the pace of store closures was slowing, but he expected more in 2019, with a handful of private equity-backed retailers on his so-called watch list. Analysts say the U.S. is still "overstored," especially when compared with other countries. As more purchases are happening online, there's less of a need for so much retail real estate. And the retailers that are still opening new locations are thinking much smaller. Already this year, Coresight said retailers have announced 1,411 store openings (offsetting about 65 percent of store closures), largely stemming from dollar and discount chains.

Department store chains and specialty apparel retailers, meanwhile, are the two categories within retail still expected to shrink. But not everyone views store closures as bad news.

"You don't always look at store closures as a negative thing," said Brandon Famous, senior managing director



of the retail advisory group at commercial real estate services firm CBRE. "That doesn't always dictate consumer sentiment. All the numbers point up," he added, referring to the industry forecasts for retail sales growth in 2019. "With any vacant department store, an owner has the opportunity to increase their rent, to reinvigorate or reinvent the space," Famous said. "In many cases a landlord looks forward to the opportunity of getting that space back. In many cases it will be a positive thing."

Mohammed bin Salman orders release of 850 Indian prisoners

Marking another significant point in India- Saudi Arabia ties, Saudi Crown Prince, Mohammed bin Salman, has ordered the release of 850 Indian prisoners lodged in jails in his country on the request of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, read a statement from the Ministry of External Affairs.

Along with the release of the prisoners, the External Affairs Ministry said the Saudi Crown Prince has also announced the increase in quota for Indian Haj pilgrims to 2 lakh at the request of PM Modi. "

Another big deliverable! At the request of the PM @narendramodi, His Royal Highness the Crown Prince of Saudi Arabia has ordered the release of 850 Indian prisoners lodged in Saudi jails," Foreign Affairs Ministry spokesperson Raveesh Kumar tweeted.

The Saudi Crown Prince arrived in India a day after his visit to Pakistan. In a special gesture which emphasises the importance India attaches to its gulf partner (Saudi Arabia) PM Modi broke protocol to personally receive the Saudi prince and welcomed him with a warm hug at Palam airport.

4 ways to get better sleep

Relaxation techniques. A racing or worried mind is the enemy of sleep. Sometimes physical tension is to blame. Techniques to quiet a racing mind — such as meditation, breathing exercises, progressive muscle relaxation, and biofeedback — can help you sleep better.

Cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT). CBT for insomnia aims to change the negative thoughts and beliefs about sleep into positive ones. People with insomnia tend to become preoccupied with sleep and apprehensive about the consequences of poor sleep. This worry makes relaxing and falling a sleep nearly impossible. The basic tenets of this therapy include setting realistic goals and learning to let go of inaccurate thoughts that can interfere with sleep. The world looks very different at 3 a.m. when you're lying in bed staring at the ceiling or the clock. "How will I make it through tomorrow without any sleep?" you worry. You may wonder how to sleep better every night. If you regularly can't get to sleep — or stay asleep — and it's affecting you during the day, then you may have insomnia.

Prescription or over-the-counter sleep aids can help you drift off, but these drugs also have side effects. These include morning drowsiness, which can make activities like driving or using machinery dangerous, and an increased risk for falling. There are other ways to sleep better than medications.

Try simple lifestyle changes to help you sleep better, recommends Dr. Hadine Joffe, associate professor of psychiatry at Harvard Medical School. Two good tips to help you sleep better include avoiding caffeine and stick ing to a regular sleep schedule. If these steps don't help you sleep better, it's worth a call to your doctor to see if a medical condition — such as thyroid problems, anemia, sleep apnea, menopausal hot flashes, heartburn, incontinence, or depression — is affecting the quality or the quantity of your sleep. Treating the health problem may take care of the sleep problem.

The guide below can help you establish a sleep routine to promote restful nights and to help you sleep better.



Your Daily Sleep Guide

This morning-to-evening, sleep-promoting schedule may help you sleep better.

Morning

7:00 a.m. Wake up at the same time each morning, even on weekends.

Limit yourself to just one cup of caf-8:00 a.m. feinated coffee at breakfast, or drink decaf. Too much caffeine in the morning can stay with you until bedtime. (If you're used to drinking several cups of coffee a day, wean yourself off it gradually over a few weeks.)

9:00 a.m. Get outside for a 30-minute walk. Both exercise and morning sunlight can help you sleep better. Evening

6:00 p.m. Eat a light dinner. A heavy meal can lead to heartburn, which can keep you awake. Avoid caffeinated tea, coffee, and soda, as well as alcohol and chocolate.

Turn off your TV, computer, cell phone, 9:15 p.m. and tablet at least 30 minutes before bed. They stimulate the brain. Read a book (not on a tablet), take a warm bath, or listen to soft music to help your body and mind unwind before bed.

Get your bedroom ready for sleep. Dim 9:45 p.m. the lights, close the curtains, make sure the temperature is cool and comfortable, and cover your alarm clock so you can't see the time if you do wake up in the middle of the night.

10:00 p.m. Use the bathroom.

Lights out. Try to go to bed at the same 10:15 p.m. time every night. If you can't fall asleep in 15 minutes, leave the bedroom. Sit somewhere quiet, like the couch, and read a book for 15-20 minutes or until you get sleepy. Then go back to bed.

The Supreme Court had on December 14 dismissed a batch of pleas challenging the deal between India and France for procurement of 36 Rafale jets, saying there was no occasion to "really doubt the decision making process" warranting setting aside of the contract. Rafale Price Could Have Been Reduced, Says CAG; Criticises Selection of Fighter Jets.

The apex court had rejected the pleas seeking lodging of an FIR and a court-monitored probe into alleged irregularities in the Rs 58,000-crore deal, in which both the countries have entered into an inter-governmental agreement (IGA). Meanwhile, speaking on the Rafale deal controversy, Dassault Aviation Chief Executive Officer (CEO) Eric Trappier on Wednesday said that there was "no scandal with Rafale deal". The CEO also added that besides 36 fighter jets, if the Indian government wants more aircraft, then we will be "pleased to deliver".

The opposition has been accusing Modi government of extending benefits to businessman Anil Ambani by buy-



ing overpriced Rafale fighter jets and helping Reliance get the offset contract from Dassault. The opposition-led by Congress has been highlighting the Rafale deal ahead of the 2019 Lok Sabha elections.

US: 70-year-old Indian-origin man admits to multi-million dollar immigration fraud

A 70-year-old man of Indian-origin, Hardev Panesar, living in the US, has admitted to running a multi-million dollar immigration scam that is said to have duped over a 100 people.

According to the US Department of Justice (DoJ), Panesar pled guilty to his crimes in the San Diego Federal Court on Thursday, and agreed to pay back \$2.5mn to the victims.

Here's more.

Panesar: Panesar would charge exorbitant sums from his victims

Born in Kenya, and fluent in five languages, Panesar had, for years, pretended to be a US government official in a bid to trick immigrants.

Over a five-year period, Panesar told dozens of immigrants that he was an official of the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), and promised to get their families legal immigration status in exchange for sums ranging between \$20,000 and \$40,000.

Arrest: He had been arrested in June 2017

Yet, that's not all.

Apart from his fraudulent activities, Panesar would often threaten clients with violence when they asked for their money back. In one case, he event threatened to behead someone.

After a year-long investigation by the FBI, Panesar was arrested in June 2017, but was granted bail on a \$100,000 bond.

Then, things took a turn.

Escape: In June last year, Panesar had escaped to Mexico

In January last year, Panesar's attorney appealed that he be allowed to leave his home detention between 6am and 10pm.

Owing to Panesar having performed well on his bail bond, the court granted him permission.



Months later, in June 2018, Panesar tampered with his GPS anklet, and fled to Mexico, just before his trial was about to begin.

Other details: However, he was deported, and faces 20 years in prison

However, Panesar's escape was shortlived, and Mexican authorities caught him within a month and deported him back to the US in August.

Out of options, Panesar has now cut short the trial process, and has pleaded guilty.

While the court is slated to sentence him in May, one of his associates has been handed a nearly four-year prison term.

Panesar faces a maximum prison term of 20 years.

Pompeo Denies 'ISIS Bride' Request to Return to U.S.

Secretary of State Mike Pompeo said Wednesday that an Alabama woman who fled to Syria to join ISIS in 2014 is not a U.S. citizen and, as a result, is not entitled to return to the U.S. with her 18-month-old son, as she had hoped to do.

"Ms. Hoda Muthana is not a U.S. citizen and will not be admitted into the United States," Pompeo said in a statement. "She does not have any legal basis, no valid U.S. passport, no right to a passport, nor any visa to travel to the United States. We continue to strongly advise all U.S. citizens not to travel to Syria."

Muthana, 24, was taken to a refugee camp in northeast Syria by Kurdish forces after escaping ISIS territory.

An attorney representing Muthana's parents claims she is a U.S. citizen despite the fact that her father was serving as a Yemeni diplomat when she was born in New Jersey, which, according to the State Department, means she is not entitled to birthright citizenship. Muthana's son was fathered by one of the three ISIS fighters she was married to during her time in the caliphate. In a 2015 tweet, she urged Americans to carry out domestic terror attacks.

"Americans wake up! Men and women altogether. You have much to do while you live under our greatest enemy, enough of your sleeping!" she wrote, according to The Guardian. "Go on drivebys, and spill all of their blood, or rent a big truck and drive all over them. Veterans, Patriots, Memorial, etc day... Kill them."

In a recent interview with The Guardian, Muthana pleaded with U.S. officials to allow her return to America, citing her youth and immaturity at the time she fled to Syria.

"I would tell them please forgive me for being so ignorant, and I was really young and ignorant and I was 19 when I decided to leave," she said.

An Encounter With The Author Of Kuch Meri Baki Tulsi ki

The Boards of Public Sector Undertakings in India normally are made of a CMD, Functional Directors, Independent Directors, Functional Directors and a Company Secretary. All Directors are appointed by the President of India on the recommendation of the Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC), who is the nominal owner/ shareholder of the companies .As per Companies Act, SEBI guidelines and the management practices, the PSUs are board managed, audited by, internal auditors, statutory auditors CAG. In spite of such a charged functional responsibilities to the Board, there is not an institution in India, which formally trains an executive to qualify to be a Director or a CMD. Invariably a good performing executive in a particular discipline is made a director, for which he may not be suitable otherwise. But, then there is no better system. Government has created Public Enterprises Selection Board (PESB), for interviewing and recommending candidates for appointment by ACC. PESB is made up of members who are generally retired civil servants who enjoy the perks more than what they are required to do. During an interview, if they get a call from ,say from PMO, the job is done . PESB would recommend two names and the choice has to be in that order.I was made CMD during July 2002, though not being the first choice, the first choice lacked a Vigilance clearance from CVC. During this period the company was in a very turbulent period due to lack of liquidity and attrition . I had seven companies to oversee, spread over the states of Karnataka, AP, Kerala, Haryana, Rajasthan, Maharashtra, J&K with employee strength of about 25000. The workers unions AITUC, INTUC, HMS, etc had taken full advantage of declining financial health of the company coupled with lack of focus by the Government. When the management attempts to bring an order in the administration, the Unions would indulge in sending petitions

to the MPs, Ministries, PMO et al. and local MPs gladly issue a covering letter and even ask some questions in the Lok Sabha. I too had my share of getting undesirable publicity in print and electronic media. Looking back, it is fun and perhaps all managers enjoy after they retire recalling the happenings.

The Bangalore Factory which was in perpetual need of funds for salaries, statutory dues, etc. was centre of focus as was located near the Corporate head quarters . Employees use to take frequent loans from their Provident Fund (EPF) citing some reason or the other. The employees including officers waiting for their loans from EPF, to be sanctioned would approach the Union leaders, who in turn bully their way with the PF Officer, intimidate him and get the files of their supporters cleared for payment. There was utter lack of discipline and the office bearers of the Unions were like warlords and law unto themselves. The previous management seemed very benevolent towards the Union leaders, no attendance punch card, and a monthly hired taxi to move around in Bangalore. The taxi would even make some private trips for others to earn some money for them. The situation was pathetic I had to do something, to begin with, I introduced attendance card punching for all employees including the CMD. I directed the Wages dept to link salaries to attendance of the leaders as was the practice for others. The effect was devastating on them. Across the country in all 21 factories, the Union leaders suffered huge salary cuts. They could not take it, and petitions and anonymous letters poured into PMO/Ministry through all important offices with allegations of all sorts.

As a Chairman of Group of seven companies. I had many Board meetings to attend and of course the Board of Holding Co. was at the apex, with an Additional Sec-

retary, senior IAS

officer from WB cadre from UP and a JS also a senior IAS officer of Punjab cadre, a Punjabi as directors. When one such meeting was to take place my security intelligence informed me that a group of nearly twenty union leaders have met the Additional Secretary in his hotel room and have submitted petition against CMD. The Board meeting began as scheduled and after couple of agenda items, the additional secretary suddenly pulled out a paper and started mentioning about the details of petition, I just requested him to hold on and asked him the item serial number of the agenda which he is reading, he said it is not in the agenda, then I politely told him that I am the Chairman of the meeting and nothing can be placed without the approval of the Chairman. The senior bureaucrat had no choice but to keep quiet throughout the meeting, skipped the customary Lunch after the meeting, and left for airport to catch the flight to Delhi . After few days he called me from Delhi and regretted his behavior during the Board meeting.

Few years passed by and I had retired, he use to frequent Bangalore to visit his daughter and every visit we use to jointly break the bread in a quiet restaurant or in the Club house of KSCA. He has taken up to writing books on spiritual subjects ,and recently he wrote a book titled "Kuch Meri Baki Tulsi Ki", the proceeds of the sale of copies he generously donated to the victims of floods in Uttrakhand . Now, whenever, he is in the town , we never miss to have a pure vegetarian meal together sans garlic and onions, in one of the famous vegetarian restaurants of Bangalore.

Canada looks to reunite Syrian family after fire claims seven kids

Ottawa (AFP) - Canada is looking to quickly bring over siblings of a Syrian refugee distraught over the loss of her seven children in a Halifax house fire, the prime minister said"The immigration minister is seized with this particular case," Prime Minister Justin Trudeau said when asked if Ottawa would fast-track the immigration or asylum process to bring the woman's brothers to Canada in order to provide her with family support.

The family was among tens of thousands of Syrian refugees welcomed by Canada over the past four years.

"We're looking at what can be done within our (immigration and refugee) system to give this family a little solace in a time of unbelievable tragedy," Trudeau said during a trip to Halifax.

Kawthar Barho, 30, and her family had fled the northern Syrian city of Raqa, where Islamic State militants had established their de facto capital. They settled in the Atlantic port city of Halifax in 2017. A video posted on social media showed a small crowd cheering their arrival at the airport.

Neighbors said they heard an explosion in the middle of the night Tuesday before seeing flames ravage the family's twostorey house.

Barho remains in hospital, and has been reportedly

repeating the name of her youngest child, Abdullah, who was only four months old.

Ahmed, 15, Rola, 12, Mohammed, 10, Ghala, 8, Hala, 4, and Rana, 3, also died in the blaze -- which police are continuing to investigate.

> Her husband Ebraheim suffered severe burns and is fighting for his life.

> Wednesday night, Trudeau attended a vigil in Halifax for the young victims.

Officials would not comment on the specific case, citing strict privacy laws, but said Immigration Minister Ahmed Hussen has discretion to fast-track asylum or immigration cases, including



security and medical screenings, in special circumstances.

Locals have been grieving with the mother.

"For the past year and a half, the children have been able to enjoy life as kids should be able to: going to school, riding bicycles, swimming, having friends, running in the yard, celebrating birthday parties and hanging out with the neighbors on their porch swing," the Heart Society, the non-profit group that sponsored the family, said in an online post.

"They loved every minute of it, and it seems impossible we won't hear their laughter and feel their hugs again," it said.

Millions of Syrians have fled years of civil war that have left more than 360,000 people dead.

Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez Makes Good On Her Promise Of Paying Staffers A "Living Wage"

Staffers working for Rep. Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez will be paid a minimum of \$52,000 per year, a major shift from the archaic congressional tradition of paying staff well below a living wage. The announcement comes two months after the New York congresswoman made headlines when she said she would pay congressional interns \$15 per hour and offer them benefits — another rarity, since these positions have often been unpaid.

According to a 2018 analysis by the independent congressional research firm LegiStorm, the median salary for some entry-level staff roles in Congress typically range from \$32,000 to \$36,000. In a place like Washington, D.C. — one of the most expensive cities in the country where rent averages \$2,100 per month — that means congressional staffers have traditionally found themselves moonlighting as food industry workers or taking other jobs to make ends meet.

But Ocasio-Cortez, who knows the struggle of juggling multiple gigs all too well, says that it was important to lead by example. "Leadership starts with our choices. That's why I decided that no one on my staff will make less than \$52k/year. It's likely one of the highest entrylevel salaries on the Hill. We pinch pennies elsewhere, but it's worth every dime to pay a living wage," she tweeted. The Members' Representational Allowances for the 2019

fiscal year — i.e. the operational budget given to members of Congress every session for managing their offices in D.C. and their respective districts — is \$574 million, still lower than the high of \$660 million in 2010.

To afford paying staffers a minimum of \$52,000, Ocasio-Cortez's office has a salary cap of \$80,000 — well below the median pay for positions such as chief of staff, which usually receive a salary of \$154,000. And it seems like the congresswoman's team is willing to take the pay cuts in order to offer lower-level staff a living wage. Ocasio-Cortez's team will

be comprised by 18 people — the limit for congressional offices— and her chief of staff Saikat Chakrabarti has previously said there are no volunteers in the office. Of course, this move has displeased some of Ocasio-Cortez's critics. Fox & Friends co-host Pete Hegseth said on Sunday said the trade-off was an example of "communism and socialism."



Ocasio-Cortez fired back on Twitter, saying: "The GOP is so disconnected from the basic idea that people should be paid enough to live that Fox actually thinks me paying a living wage in my office is 'communism.' So the next time GOP screams 'socialist,' know that's their go-to attack for any common-sense, humane policy."



Cook Says Apple Is 'Rolling the Dice' on Future Products

Apple Inc. Chief Executive Officer Tim Cook said he has "never been more optimistic" about where the company is today and where it's heading. In a pep talk to investors, Cook said the iPhone maker is "planting seeds" and "rolling the dice" on future products that will just "blow you away."


Speaking at the company's annual general meeting in Cupertino, California, Cook reiterated that the iPhone maker is still on track to double revenue from services in 2020 from the nearly \$25 billion in 2016. Referencing speaking notes on an iPad, Cook touched on several of the company's product categories.

He said eventually the goal is to lower the price on the \$1,200 MacBook Air laptop with a higher-resolution

screen and said there's a "long, great roadmap of fantastic" products related to the Apple Watch and AirPods. He indicated that more health features would come to the smartwatch.

Apple shares rose more than 1 percent in afternoon trading Friday in New York. The stock was down before Cook started speaking.

Investors are waiting for Apple to come up with a next big thing as demand for its best-selling product, the iPhone, slows, leading to the company's first holiday-quarter sales decline since 2001. Cook has often mentioned augmented reality as a game changing technology and Apple is working on a pair of AR glasses. In the meantime, the company is focusing on a growing services businesses and rising



The CEO also fielded questions from investors about privacy, diversity and politics. In an apparent jab at Facebook Inc. and Google, Cook criticized companies that build data profiles of their users, and reiterated that Apple is pushing for regulation against such practice. One shareholder noted that although Apple management's political opinion appears to differ from the Trump administration's, the company has still been able to successfully to work with the U.S. government.

At Apple's recommendation, shareholders rejected a proposal to disclose the ideology of board nominees. Those

in favor of the proposal indicated their desire for Apple's board to have a more diverse set of political opinions, and one shareholder said the board needs more shareholder input.

Shareholders rejected a proposal to give wider access to nominate board members. The entire board, which includes Cook, former U.S. Vice President Al Gore and Walt Disney Co. CEO Bob Iger, was re-elected.

One shareholder criticized Apple for donating \$1 million to the Southern Poverty Law Center in the wake of the violent Charlottesville, Virginia, attack in 2017. The shareholder indicated that if Apple's board was more IATIONAL PAGE diverse politically, the company might not have made the donation. Much of the room clapped when another shareholder rebuked the suggestion that Apple shouldn't have given money to the center, which monitors hate groups and combats discrimination.


When it is working as intended, the system should sound a warning if it doesn't detect the driver's hands on the wheel. If the driver doesn't respond to repeated

warnings, the car will turn on its hazard lights and slowly come to a stop.

The system's failure is a problem because a driver's inattention may increase the risk of a crash, according to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. Additionally, the system may not trigger warnings that tell drivers to keep their hands on the wheel and won't bring the vehicle to a complete stop automatically.

The recall follows a similar problem with the 2019 Lincoln Nautilus SUV. Approximately 2,700 of the SUVs were recalled in January because of a faulty handsoff detection system.


