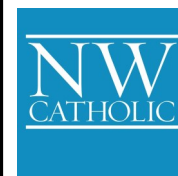
REMEMBER FAITH FORMATION SURVEYS

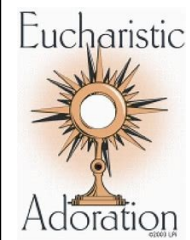

We hope to have 20 adoration of the Blessed Sacrament again on February 4, in conjunction with our Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

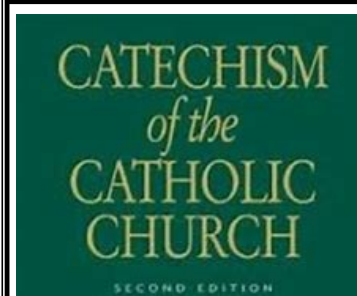

BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS

Carlo Acutis was a tech-savvy teenager, known for his love for others and his devotion to the Eucharist. He was beatified in October of 2020. He used his talents to build a website to share information about known Eucharistic miracles (recall the

display of eucharistic miracles here last spring) and created videos sharing aspects of the Catholic faith with his internet audience.

His faith extended beyond the internet as well, and he was known to befriend the poor, homeless, and migrant populations on the streets of his native city of Milan. In 2006, he died of leukemia at the age of 15. His cause for sainthood is ongoing.

Pope Francis used the example of Carlo's life in a recent apostolic exhortation, Christus Vivit: "Carlo was well aware that the whole apparatus of communications, advertising and social networking can be used to lull us, to make us addicted to consumerism and buying the latest thing on the market, obsessed with our free time, caught up in negativity. Yet he knew how to use the new communications technology to transmit the Gospel, to communicate values. This said, Carlos was a boy of his time."

Indeed, in addition to having a vibrant passion for the Eucharist and the Virgin Mary, he was also known for being a soccer fan and, above all, a computer genius. While currently his situation is not a canonization, but a beatification he is-important-today-as he-was-a-millennial-a-young-man-who-brings-holiness-into-the-third-millennium. Carlo, who was a geek, used to spend less time on his computer than we do today as he died in October 2006. Nowadays, we wake up with our laptops. We can waste so much time with this thing, yet here we see someone who has actually saved his soul by using it wisely.

Thanks to him, we know that it is up to us to make the internet a place of light instead of a place of darkness. He gives hope, because he was able to live with a pure heart in the harshness of the 21st century. His life is marked by an intergenerational dimension as well. In these times marked by the coronavirus crisis, which has severely impacted the elderly, there has been a greater need for sources of hope. Seeing a child who has been beatified gives hope for their own children.
