NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, as follows:

- 1. Proposal Description.** The San Simeon Community Services District (SSCSD) is located in the north coast of San Luis Obispo County. San Simeon is north of Cambria by about 7 miles. State Highway one bisects the District with a part of it located on the east and west sides. The District submitted an application by Resolution to activate its solid waste power. The activation was approved by LAFCO on November 19, 2020. The Conducting Authority Hearing is held pursuant to the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Act. Activation of this power would allow the current Solid Waste franchise agreement to be transferred from the County to the District. The San Simeon CSD could then use the franchise fees to administer solid waste programs within the community as well as maintain roads impacted by the garbage trucks. **No changes in the fees, service provider, or service levels are proposed.** More information is available on the LAFCO website www.slolafco.com.
- 2. Reasons for Activating Power.** Transferring the franchise agreement from the County to the District allows increased revenues to the CSD to fund direct services within the San Simeon community. Currently, the franchise fees are collected by the County and spent on a county basis.
- 3. Time, Date, Location of Hearing.** A Conducting Authority (Protest) Hearing regarding the activation of the solid waste power for San Simeon CSD will be held on **January 22, 2021, at 9:00 a.m. in a ZOOM meeting** conducted by San Luis Obispo LAFCO and LAFCO Staff. Access to the ZOOM meeting can be found above or on the SLOLAFCO website www.slolafco.com. Written protests from registered voters and/or property owners within the SSCSD boundary area may be submitted prior to or at the meeting. Only written protests will be used to determine the outcome of the protest process. The form for filing a written protest is attached or found on the SLOLAFCO website. The form must be filled out completely or it will not be considered a valid written protest. It can be mailed, dropped off to the LAFCO Office, 1042 Pacific Street, Suite A, San Luis Obispo, CA 93401 or it can also be scanned and emailed to Dchurch@slolafco.com.
- 4. Resolution of the Protest Hearing.** Written protests would be submitted to the County Assessors or Clerks Office for validation. The Executive Officer shall determine the validity and number of written protests consistent with State Law.
