An update from your bargaining committee:

In order to clear the backlog of grievances and set the stage for productive bargaining, your Local 100 President and Regional Vice-Presidents met with CN Rail in Montreal on October 10 and 11 to begin resolution discussions on 450 grievances. On October 16 and 17, with the support of the bargaining committee, discussions continued in Montreal on October 18. We made some positive progress on the outstanding grievances and the parties began to explore their respective proposals.

The next round of bargaining is scheduled to take place in Montreal on November 12 to 16.

The Bargaining Committee remains determined to bargain the best agreement possible and we would like to assure members that we are working hard to secure gains for you. To this end, we do not bargain in public and we will use this website to update you as often as possible. We would ask all members to not listen to the employer for updates, or entertain rumours as this website will be your best source for the most accurate and up to date information.
