It is good to be serving with you, saints of Bethany. With less than a month together, I can honestly say this is a very, very good church, and I feel blessed to be a part of it, if only for a time. It is particularly meaningful to be joining with you at this time of year, in the fall, with daylight's slow but steady wane, leaves turning color and falling, the days and nights taking on a chill, and the church year coming to an end. Reformation Sunday, All Saints Sunday, and the final Sundays of the late Pentecost Season, culminating in Christ the King Sunday—all of these remind us of Christ with us in the past and in the present, God's promises for the future, and the amazing gifts God gives us through all our days. I am especially grateful for the people—the multitude of saints—God has sent into my life.

My earliest memory of my personal saints were family members, family friends, neighbors, public school and Sunday School and Vacation Bible School teachers, and the host of people who showed kindness and shared God's love with me. As I grew, I was further encouraged by teachers, coaches, and mentors. In high school, our new pastor who knew his limitations (he couldn't sing) turned his lack of musical gifts into a chance for me and other high schoolers to take leadership roles singing the Sunday liturgy. (Three of us became pastors.) In my decades as a pastor, there have always been faith-filled, kind, generous, diverse, and wise church members who have borne witness of Christ's love alive in them. As I grow riper with years, I fondly remember these saints with gratitude and love, even as I mourn their passing fully into God's eternal care. (I know and love an awful lot of dead people.)

Who are the saints in your life? Remember and give thanks for them, for they are among God's best and greatest gifts. And remember, too, you saint, you are God's gift to others. You were created to be gospel—God's good news—God's love come in flesh and blood.
