- Experience Benediction, Adoration & Eucharistic Exposition
- Join others in song, prayer, worship and conversation
- Learn about God's grace within us, how this grace comes more alive in a Christian community, and how we can share this grace with others
- Come away with a clearer sense of priorities in life & faith, new friendships, and a closer relationship with God
- Men & women attend separate weekends.
- If married, couples are both encouraged to attend a CEC weekend in the same season or within a year of one another

As you come on Friday evening as a participant, you will be greeted by other men/women who have previously attended a CEC weekend and serve to help as the weekend unfolds.

CEC weekends are approved by the Archdiocese of Omaha & are held at local Catholic parishes through Omaha Metro area. Our weekends begin late Friday afternoon to Sunday evening.

There is an all-inclusive CEC weekend fee of approx. ~\$200 that covers food, lodging and materials. We find lodging at a nearby Holiday Inn Express or similar hotel. Financial Scholarships are available. Double occupancy is standard, private or handicap rooms are an extra fee.
