Misleading Finals

Washington (-9.5) beat Boise State 38-10. However, the Huskies only had a 355-311 yard edge as they were +4 in turnovers. The game was tied 3-3 mid-2Q and Boise State was stopped on downs twice in Washington territory.

Delaware (+1.5) beat UL-Lafayette 20-13. ULL had a 335-334 yard edge but were -3 in turnovers. They were intercepted in the Delaware end zone in the first quarter and were inside the Delaware 10-yard line when they dropped a TD pass on the final play of the game.

Alabama (+2) upset Oklahoma 34-24. However, Oklahoma had a 362-260 yard edge. OU led 17-0 but Alabama scored a TD on 4th down. Got a 13-yard FG "drive" after a mishandled punt snap and also got a 50-yard "Pick 6" to tie it at halftime. Oklahoma's kicker who had made 24 straight, missed two FG's in the second half.

Bad Beats

The total in the Kennesaw State/Western Michigan game was 47.5. The fourth quarter was scoreless. WMU was intercepted at the Kennesaw State 12-yard line, there was a missed 40-yard field goal and Kennesaw fumbled at the WMU-15.

Oregon (-20.5) beat James Madison 51-34. Oregon led 48-13 late in the third quarter and were inside JMU's 10-yard line. The Ducks thre a pick. In the 4Q, JMU went 89 yards in 9 plays for a TD and then 99 yards in 9 plays for a late backdoor.

Games in Rotation Order

Wednesday, December 24th

Hawai'i Bowl - T.C. Ching Athletics Complex - Honolulu, HI

California 27 HAWAII 25. Hawaii is playing in their first bowl game since 2020. They are 7-5 all-time playing at home in bowl action. They are the better team in the stats with a 0.0 ypp margin (Cal -0.5) but Cal played the tougher schedule (No. 60 vs No. 112). Cal will be led by interim coach Nick Rolovich who coached at Hawaii from 2016-2019 and also was the starting QB here in 2001. Both teams are banged up a bit but it looks like there will be limited opt outs. Cal QB Jaron-Keawe Sagapolutele should play. We lean Cal.

Friday, December 26th

Sports Bowl - Ford Field - Detroit, MI

† **Northwestern 27 Central Michigan 17.** Both teams should be excited to be playing in the post-season. CMU's win total was only 5.5 and they had a first-year coach in Matt Drinkall. Northwestern's win total was only 3.5 but they managed their 2nd bowl in three years under David Braun. CMU was better in the stats (0.0 vs -0.3 in ypp margin) but Northwestern played the much tougher schedule (No. 36 vs No. 132). Both teams have few opt outs. Northwestern was a little banged up at RB and DL in the last few games but should be healthier here. Northwestern is usually a team we don't like to lay points with.

Rate Bowl - Chase Field - Phoenix, AZ

† **Minnesota 24 New Mexico 21.** New Mexico first-year HC Jason Eck did as fine of a job as any coach in the country this year. The Lobos win total was only 3.5 but they managed 9 wins. They were banged up a bit down the stretch but should be healthier here. Meanwhile, Minnesota could be down a few players including WR Le'Meke Brockington who declared for the NFL. New Mexico was much better in the stats (+0.6 in ypp margin vs Minnesota -0.7) but obviously the Gophers played the much tougher schedule (No. 56 vs No. 90). We understand the early money on New Mexico but PJ Fleck is a perfect 6-0 in bowl games at Minnesota.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

First Responder Bowl - Gerald J. Ford Stadium - Dallas, TX

† **Utah 34 FIU 27.** FIU first-year head coach Willie Simmons did a great job getting FIU to their first bowl since 2019. They were playing their best ball down the stretch winning and covering their final four games. UTSA was up-and-down all season. They did play a much tougher schedule than FIU (No. 80 vs No. 137). Both teams will be missing quite a few players. FIU's entire secondary is in the transfer portal along with a couple of offensive linemen. UTSA head coach Jeff Traylor says he expects to be without 10-20 players and that could include a half-dozen starters on defense. With so many missing defensive players, we prefer the OVER.

Saturday, December 27th

Military Bowl - Navy-Marine Corps Stadium - Annapolis, MD

† **Pittsburgh 32 East Carolina 23.** Originally, we liked ECU in this game. However, the Pirates will be without their OC and DC who left to take different jobs. Additionally, starting QB Katin Houser (3,300 passing yards, 66%, 19-6 TD-to-INT ratio) hit the transfer portal and won't play here. ECU will also be without WR Yannick Smith, TE Jayvontay Conner and OT Jimarion McCrimmon. Pitt will be playing without RB Desmond Reid and LB Kyle Louis who are two of their very best players. This line opened Pitt -10.5, went down to Pitt -4 and now we're back up to where we started. Don't you love bowl season?

Pinstripe Bowl - Yankee Stadium - Bronx, NY

† **Clemson 24 Penn State 21.** In August if someone told you Penn State and Clemson would be playing each other, you would think it would be in the CFB Playoff semi-finals. Easily two of the most disappointing teams in CFB this year. Both will be a shell of themselves here. Penn State will be down at least five starters including RB Singleton and DT Durant. They'll also have a skeleton coaching staff with multiple assistants taking other jobs. Clemson head coach Dabo Swinney said 27 players will miss the bowl game. At least 10 of those were starters including their entire DL. QB Klubnik will play here. Snow is in the forecast. We lean UNDER in what will basically be an exhibition game.

Fenway Bowl - Fenway Park - Boston, MA

† **Army 27 Connecticut 17.** If Connecticut were completely healthy here and had their head coach, we'd be looking at the Huskies favored by a FG here. However, Jim Mora left for Colorado State. UConn has as many as eight starters out for this game including QB Joe Fagnano. Army appears to be fully healthy. When bowl games started to become less and less significant, service academies have thrived. Army, Navy and Air Force are a combined 18-3 SU and 18-3 ATS since 2013 in bowl games. You don't have to worry about opt outs or motivation with them. You know what you're getting and that's max effort. The problem is the market is starting to catch on with this line opening UConn -3.5 and now Army is laying almost doubles.

Pop-Tarts Bowl - Camping World Stadium - Orlando, FL

† **Byu 30 Georgia Tech 25.** One of the better bowl matchups in what has become one of the better marketed bowl games in recent years. 11-2 BYU was +0.9 in ypp margin but 9-3 Georgia Tech fared better at +1.2. BYU did play the tougher schedule (No. 34 vs No. 57). Georgia Tech will be without a couple of starters and their OC Buster Faulkner left for Florida. Chris Weinke will take over the play-calling. QB Haynes King, RB Jamal Haynes and WR Eric Rivers are all expected to play. BYU looks like they will be full-go here with the exception of RB LJ Martin. We lean with BYU.

Arizona Bowl - Arizona Stadium - Tucson, AZ

† **Fresno State 25 Miami, OH 18.** Both teams were +0.6 in ypp margin this year and Miami, OH actually played the slightly tougher schedule. So why are they catching a TD here? Their starting WR Kam Perry who led the nation in yards per catch hit the portal. Their best pass rusher Adam Trick is in the portal as well as starting CB Mychal Yharbrough and OL Drew Terrill. The RedHawks were already playing down the stretch without their starting QB and could be without LB Corban Hondru again. Fresno was a little banged up on defense at the end of the year but should be good to go here.

New Mexico Bowl - University Stadium - Albuquerque, NM

† **North Texas 28 San Diego State 24.** If both teams were full-go, this would have been one of the better bowl matchups. The two teams are a combined 19-6 ATS covering their games by an average of 7.8 points per game. North Texas was +2.1 in ypp margin this year vs the No. 92 schedule. San Diego State was +1.3 in ypp margin. Unfortunately, both teams will be compromised. North Texas will be without HC Eric Morris who is off to Oklahoma State. They will also be without starting QB Drew Mestemaker and a few other starters. Keep an eye on RB Caleb Hawkins status. San Diego State lost their DC to Nebraska. Their starting QB Jayden Denegal had surgery and will not play along with a couple of starting WR's. Bert Emanuel (great runner, horrible passer) will get the start at QB. We lean UNDER. Note San Diego State did just play in this stadium for the regular season finale.

Gator Bowl - Everbank Stadium - Jacksonville, FL

† **Missouri 26 Virginia 21.** Virginia should be excited to be bowling for the first time since 2019. However, they were also very close to making the CFB Playoffs but lost in OT in the ACC Championship game. As of press-time, they have limited opt outs other than starting CB Ja'Son Prevard. Meanwhile, Missouri lost starting QB Beau Pribula to the transfer portal and will be down a few WR's and their starting TE. We expect them to lean heavily on the run game. Missouri was better in the stats (+1.4 ypp margin vs +0.8) and played the tougher schedule (No. 27 vs No. 62). We have a slight lean on Mizzou.

Texas Bowl - NRG Stadium- Houston, TX

† **Houston 23 Lsu 20.** Obviously, Houston is playing close to home and should be excited to be playing a big-time program. We question how excited LSU will be. They have an interim coach and it looks like more and more opt outs are to be expected. Right now they are down six starters. QB Michael Van Buren will again get the start like he did the final few games of the regular season. Meanwhile Houston QB Conner Weigman should play as he is returning to Houston in 2026. They did lose starting center Demetrius Hunter. LSU played the much tougher schedule (No. 9 vs No. 69) but they were a shell of themselves offensively down the stretch including a 13-10 win over WKU.

Monday, December 29th

Birmingham Bowl - Protective Stadium- Houston, TX

† **Georgia Southern 31 Appalachian State 25.** Obviously, a rematch of an earlier meeting which saw Georgia Southern upset Appalachian State 25-23 as 5-point road underdogs. So why is Appalachian State a 7-point dog now on a neutral? Well, they have 28 players in the transfer portal (more than any other bowl team) and 7 of them are starters. They could be down to a 3rd string QB. Meanwhile, Georgia Southern has had a limited number of opt outs. They were banged up a bit on offense in the regular season finale. We prefer UNDER at current.

Tuesday, December 30th

Independence Bowl - Independence Stadium- Shreveport, LA

† **Louisiana Tech 31 Coastal Carolina 22.** Louisiana Tech's campus is about an hour away so expect them to have a crowd edge. Coastal Carolina fired their head coach Tim Beck and DC Jeremiah Johnson will serve as the interim here. Coastal will be without LT Nick Del Grande and will probably be missing QB Samari Collier as well (knee). LT will be without S Michael Richard, S Jacob Fields and LB Mekhi Mason. Trey Kukuk should get the start at QB as he ran for 143 yards and 2 TD's vs Liberty and 172 yards and 3 TD's vs Missouri State in the final two games. We lean OVER which is 8-3-1 in Coastal games.

Music City Bowl - Nissan Stadium- Nashville, TN

† **Tennessee 32 Illinois 28.** Tennessee should have a big crowd edge playing in their home state. WR Chris Brazzell and LB Arion Carter are off to the NFL and won't play. They will also likely be without TE Miles Kitselman and they fired their DC Tim Banks. As of press-time Illinois is only down LB Gabe Jacas and OL JC Davis. Tennessee was better in ypp margin (+1.1 vs +0.6) but Illinois played the slightly tougher schedule (No. 31 vs No. 40). We bet Illinois +8.5 on the openers but would lean Tennessee -2.5 at current. Numbers matter.

Alamo Bowl - Alamodome- San Antonio, TX

† **Usc 31 Tcu 25.** Another bowl game with opt outs being the main story. USC has 11 starters out! It includes WR's Ja'Kobi Lane and Makai Lemon, TE Lake McRee, LB Eric Gentry, S Kamari Ramsey, S Bishop Fitzgerald and a few lineman on both sides. QB Jayden Maiava will play. The same can't be said for TCU starting QB Josh Hoover who hit the portal. USC was much better in the stats (+1.6 ypp margin vs +0.7) and played the tougher schedule (No. 35 vs No. 47). However, with all the opt outs, we're sitting on the sidelines here.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Thursday, December 25th-MERRY CHRISTMAS!

Dallas 29 WASHINGTON 21. The NFL and their TV partners cannot be happy with what's transpired for this Christmas slate. The Cowboys have been eliminated from the playoffs and Washington is down to a 3rd string QB in Josh Johnson. Dallas won the earlier meeting 44-22 as 1.5-point favorites back on October 19th. Dallas games are on a 9-2-1 run to the OVER. If you need a stocking stuffer on Christmas, we don't mind teasing the Cowboys down to -1 with Detroit -1.5 (also on Christmas Day).

Detroit 24 MINNESOTA 17. Just a brutal loss for the Lions on Sunday at home to the Steelers as two offensive PI's negated TD's in the final seconds. It was the first time the Lions have suffered back-to-back losses in more than three years. It also pretty much eliminated them from the playoffs. Minnesota has won and covered three straight. However, Max Brosmer will get the start here. The last time he started, the Vikings were shut out. We like Detroit in a teaser with Dallas.

Denver 24 KANSAS CITY 11. The Chiefs have secured their first losing season since 2012. Backup QB Minshew tore his ACL a week after Mahomes did and now the Chiefs will turn to Chris Oladokun. KC is 0-7 ATS in their last 7. Denver beat KC 22-19 as 4.5-point home underdogs and now are 13.5-point road favorites. What a downfall for the Chiefs in less than two months. Denver is still the No. 1 seed in the AFC despite last week's loss but need to be somewhat focused here with the Pats, Jags and Chargers right behind them. KC games were 9-1 to the UNDER with Mahomes. Can't see the offense doing much with a 3rd stringer.

Saturday, December 27th

GREEN BAY 22 Baltimore 19. The Packers blew a late 10-point 4Q lead at Chicago last week and lost in OT. That would have given them the division lead and the No. 2 seed. Now they're sitting as the No. 7 seed. Malik Willis will be ready to start here if Jordan Love can't clear concussion protocol. Lamar Jackson has not practiced and we're not sure if he will play here. The Ravens are on a 1-5 ATS run. They are arguably the most disappointing team in the NFL this year. This is only their 3rd game as an underdog (other two were when Jackson was out) and yet they are 7-8.

L.A. CHARGERS 20 Houston 19. Two of the hottest teams in the AFC. The Chargers have won and covered four in a row despite being banged up. After a 0-3 start, Houston is 10-2 SU and 8-4 ATS in their last 12. The Chargers are better on ypp margin (+0.4 vs +0.2) but Houston has played the tougher schedule (No. 7 vs No. 28). Houston also ranks better in DVOA (No. 5 vs No. 14) and Sagarin (No. 5 vs No. 14). We lean with the and love them in a teaser.

Sunday, December 28th

CINCINNATI 31 Arizona 24. Every few games, the Bengals show what they could have been this year and last week was one of those games with them crushing the Dolphins. Meanwhile, the Cardinals are 0-7 SU and 1-6 ATS in their last 7 games. This is the largest favorite role of the season for the Bengals and it's tough trusting them laying this kind of number with their poor defense.

Seattle 24 CAROLINA 17. Seattle has extra time to prep after their thrilling come-from-behind win over the Rams. The Seahawks trailed 30-14 late in the 4Q but won 38-37 in OT thanks to three converted 2-pointers. They are now the No. 1 seed in the NFC. Carolina is also off a big win as they upset Tampa Bay to take a 1-game lead in the division. They are fraudulent in the metrics ranking No. 24 in DVOA, No. 25 in ypp margin and No. 24 in Sagarin. Meanwhile, Seattle ranks No. 2 in DVOA, No. 1 in ypp margin and No. 2 in Sagarin. Don't mind Seattle in a teaser.

LAS VEGAS 21 N.Y. Giants 20. The Giants have been favored just once this year, they lost outright to Washington. QB Jaxson Dart was awful last week going 7 of 13 for 33 yards and interception with a 4.7 QBR. Las Vegas' offense finally got going last week as they broke a 6-game streak of scoring 17 or less and gaining 275 yards or less (still lost 23-21 to Houston). That was the longest streak in the NFL since the 2008 Cleveland Browns. Both are -0.7 in ypp margin. Both have played Top 4 schedules in terms of difficulty. We lean with the Raiders.

Pittsburgh 20 CLEVELAND 16. Pittsburgh's 29-24 win over Detroit as 7.5-point underdogs was one of the better wins of the season. It moved them one step closer to the playoffs which they can get with a win here (or a Baltimore loss to Green Bay the night before). In their 3-game win streak Pittsburgh is +0.7 in ypp margin. The Browns rank No. 32 in DVOA. We like the road favorite here despite the low total. The worry for us would be Pittsburgh's focus if they have already clinched the division prior to the game. Also check weather. Heavy rain and wind.

New Orleans 20 TENNESSEE 17. Don't look now but the Saints have won three straight and covered 4 straight. They are clearly building for the future. Tennessee has quietly gone 5-1-1 ATS in their last 7 and got an upset over the Chiefs last week (albeit KC was down to a 3rd string QB). First road favorite role of the year for New Orleans. Will they take another step? Their games are on a 10-1 run to the UNDER.

Tampa Bay 24 MIAMI 21. The market sure loves this Tampa Bay team despite their 1-6 straight up and 0-7 ATS mark in their last 7 games. They were favored in 5 of those 7 games. Switching up QB's didn't help the Dolphins last week as they were blown out at home to the Bengals. Quinn Ewers (20 of 30 for 260 yards and 2 INT's) will get the start again here. As bad as Miami was last week, we can't bet Tampa as a road favorite right now.
