All registered parishioners with a valid email address in our parish software program will automatically be signed up for the free subscription. You may unsubscribe if desired.

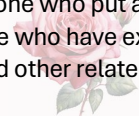

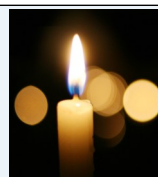
All Saints and All Souls Day Mass Schedule
