### **Notice to Insurers Regarding Catastrophe Adjuster Registration**

In order to better track catastrophe adjusters brought into the state by insurers pursuant to La. R.S. 22:1667 and Regulation 113 (LAC 37:XII.Chapter 163), the Louisiana Department of Insurance (LDI) has made changes to the information that must be submitted to register those adjusters. Please review the information at <https://ldi.la.gov/industry/producer-adjuster/emergency-adjuster-registrations> and be guided accordingly.

Only insurers or their designee may register catastrophe adjusters, and they must be registered using the "Catastrophic Adjuster Registration" module of the Industry Access System. The LDI strongly encourages companies to obtain the required User IDs and module permissions sooner rather than waiting for the development of a named storm and to prepare the spreadsheets in advance when possible. This will help prevent delays in the deployment of adjusters.

Only individuals may be registered as catastrophe adjusters. Individuals with an active adjuster or public adjuster license in Louisiana cannot be registered as a catastrophe adjuster, and individuals who are residents of Louisiana cannot be registered as catastrophe adjusters.
