

# 2025 CSRHA YEAR END AWARD CLASSES AND RULES

## ~ CLASSES ~

### REINING CLASSES

- CSRHA Green Horse - \$200.00 earnings limit on horse
- CSRHA Green Reiner L2- \$350.00 earnings limit on rider. This is a non pro class.
- CSRHA Rookie L2 - \$1,500.00 earnings limit on rider
- CSRHA Non Pro Reining
- CSRHA Limited Non Pro - Lifetime rider earnings of less than \$10,000.00
- CSRHA Prime Time Non Pro - Riders must be 50 or older at the beginning of the calendar year
- CSRHA Novice Horse Non Pro L2 - \$25,000.00 earnings limit on horse
- CSRHA Novice Horse Open L2 - \$25,000.00 earnings limit on horse
- CSRHA Open Reining
- CSRHA Limited Open - Lifetime rider earnings of less than \$10,000.00
- CSRHA Youth 13 and under
- CSRHA Youth 14 thru 18
- CSRHA Short stirrup 10 and under

### RANCH CLASSES

- CSRHA Ranch Riding (open to all)
- CSRHA Novice Ranch Riding
- CSRHA Youth Ranch Riding
- CSRHA Ranch Trail (open to all)
- CSRHA Youth Ranch Trail

## ~SHOW AWARD RULES~

- Both owner and rider must be members of CSRHA prior to showing in the class for which they want points to count toward year-end.
- Points are accumulated based on the "same horse/rider" combination throughout the current show season.
- Riders must show in all four (4) CSRHA shows (same CSRHA class). Year-end awards will be based on the best three (3) of four (4) class placings:  
June 7 - CSRHA Fun Day,  
June 8 - CSRHA Fun Day,  
July 26 - CSRHA Fun Day,  
July 27 - NRHA & CSRHA Show



## ~ SCORE/POINTS ~

### Reining Classes

- Numerical scores from the judge's sheet will be reported.
- Points will be awarded using points using 10 points (first place) to 1 point (10th place).
- Points will be averaged in the case of ties. For example, if the top two scores are both 71: Using the 10 point scale, both competitors would receive 9.5 points (10 + 9 divided by 2 equals 9.5 points).

### Ranch Riding and Ranch Trail:

- Numerical scores from the Judge's sheet will be reported.
- Ties will be broken using the score(s) from predetermined maneuvers chosen by the judge.
- Points will be awarded using 10 points (first place) to 1 point (tenth place).

*\* A rider receiving a score of zero (0) or no score will not receive points.*
