February 17, 2018

President Jan Frazier called the meeting to order at the Georgetown Public Library, Georgetown, Texas at 9:30 am. New members and guests were introduced. All present were welcomed by Jan.

Reports:

- A. Treasurer- Alora Johns – CTPS currently has an operating capital of just over \$6000.00

- E. Programs Chair – Jane Frederick – Next month's program will be a field trip to the art studio of Will Klem in Austin. His studio is located at 516 Navasota in east Austin. Members will meet in the Georgetown Library parking lot and carpool to Mr. Klem's studio. Everyone is asked to bring a folding chair to the meeting at Klem's studio. The April and May meetings will be held at 301 W. Bagdad in Round Rock at the Baca Center.
- F. Webmaster – Jane Frederick – There is a bug in the CTPS website and Jane is having problems receiving notices. If something is sent to her, and no response is given within 8 hours, then it needs to be resent to her personal email.
